Guided Instruction

Whenever you stop and take time to share an idea, help someone, raise your hand in class or help at home, you are planting a seed in the ground that will one day grow. It can grow large or it can stay small. The choice will always be yours!

Activity:

Making a tree that represents me. Today we will start with making leaves. A tree needs good things to grow and so do I! The leaves represent good things that I can do to plant good seeds.

Teacher: Put kids into groups.

Tip: Have a few students who have been attentive and following the PAS rules, Pass out green construction paper.

Students cut out large leaf shapes and write their name on the back of each leaf.

Teacher Says: "Write down ways that you can plant good seeds that grow. Here are a few examples:

Helping friends, helping at school or home, following the rules, cleaning up after yourself, telling the truth, not talking about people, being a leader.

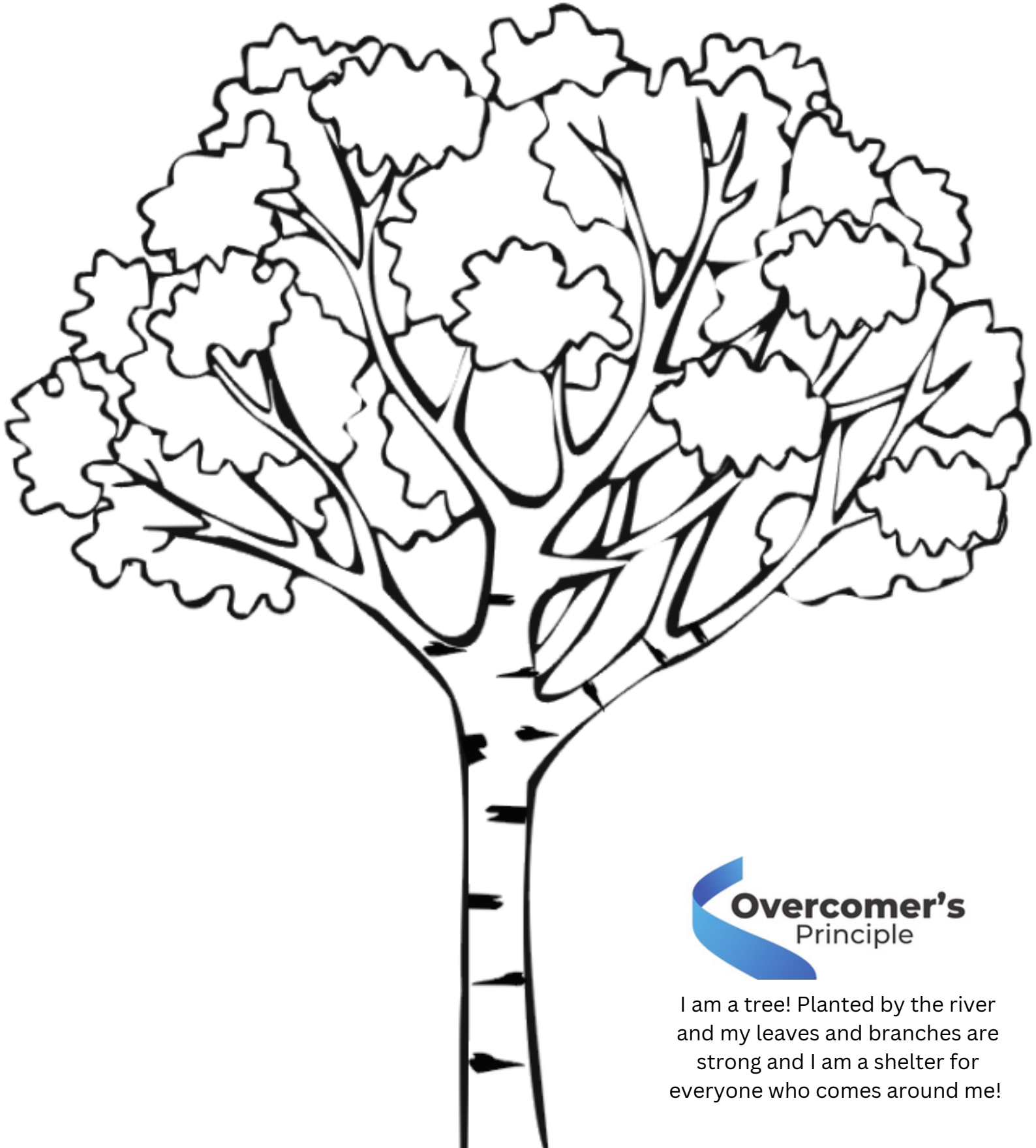
