There is no one else in the world like you! You have your own set of fingerprints, your own set of eyes, and your smile is like nobody else's on this entire planet! That makes you very special just like a zebra!

Teacher: Why are we talking about eyes, fingers, and zebras? We have been talking about how human beings share some things in common with other parts of creation. Today we are talking about things we have in common with the Zebra. First, here are a few fun facts: Our Fingerprints are made of several layers of twisted skin that formed before we were born.

Take a minute and look at the ridges and patterns on your thumb. No one else has the same pattern as you!

Run a finger across your thumb...can you feel the ridges? The ridges you feel help us to get a grip on objects that we're trying to grasp. Without them, things would slide right out of our hands!

Now here's the fun fact about a Zebra that is very similar to your fingerprint; All zebras have unique stripe patterns meaning that no other zebra has the same pattern!! Do you see the similarity here?

Fact: You are unique which means that there is no one else like you! So why are we talking about you? Because what you do with your uniqueness determines who you are.

It is important what you do with your uniqueness because somebody needs you.
