Goals

Chalkboard

Check-in -How are we doing? Each student takes their temperature using the spin chart game. If a student needs to share, create a space for them to do that in a non-threatening trauma-informed way

Guided Instruction:

Four Main positions in soccer:

Midfielder- this player's job is to protect the back line and stopping opposition attacks.

Defender- Center back defender job is to stop the opposition from getting the ball.

Goalie- this player's job is to stop the opposition from scoring

Forward- They are the offensive players, and their job is to score

What are the four main positions in school:

Students must go to school

Students must choose to learn

Students must be a part of the team

Students must have a plan

Do you see anything that is common among all four positions?

What do you think they need to score?

If you said they need to work as a team, you were right!!

They need each other...the goalkeeper cannot bring the team to victory alone. He needs the other players. The midfielder and defender can't get the team to victory alone. They need the other players. The same thing applies here!! You need a team around you to succeed, and you also need to know who you are and your position.



Activity One:

Students identify the positions on the soccer field (using the coloring page), discuss what they are doing, and then color the pictures.

Discuss the roles they are playing similar to the "positions" they are filling to be a part of their "team" (school, family and community)

Activity Two:
