CHECK IN SPINNERS

When you look at something with “A Bird’s Eye View,” you look at it from above...You are looking at it as if you are flying high in the sky like a bird, from a high angle or a high vantage point.

We can also call this an Aerial View – From the air, like a bird or an airplane.

Guided Instruction:

Activity One:

Cut out and make glasses.

Put your Aerial Glasses on...As you look down, you can see all of the people and places on the ground, and if you use your imagination, it may even look like a big picture or a big map.

Take a minute and look through your glasses and think of some ingredients that made you: your parents, siblings, and other family members, maybe something you learned, or a friend and teacher may even be included. Look at the ingredients that are a part of you.
