



I clearly remember where I was on the morning of September 11, 2001. We watched as terrorists attacked our country, striking the World Trade Center in New York City, the Pentagon, and a field in Pennsylvania where United Flight 93 crashed. In one morning, we felt our world change forever.

We had entered a strange new world, ushered in by 19 men, who we must call our enemies, who hijacked four planes. These were not our friends, these were people that were full of hatred towards our country, for what we stand and for what we are. The event changed everything: how we travel, how wars are fought—how we live.

The question is, how many people still remember that terrible event? Ancient Israel had a short memory span. Over and over, the Bible recounts how they “remembered not” and forgot that blessings came from Elohim. All we have to do is read Judges 8:34 and Psalm 78:42.

Yahuwah stated in Jeremiah 7:25 **“From the day that your fathers came out of the land of Egypt to *this day*, I have *persistently* sent all My servants the prophets to them, day after day”** *Revised Standard Version*).

Despite these constant reminders, **“They hearkened not unto Me, nor inclined their ear, but hardened their neck: they did worse than their fathers”** Jeremiah 7:26

The example of ancient Israel is a lesson for their modern-day descendants. May we never forget what took place at that time and teach our children!

Let's look at a parable of Yahusha (Jesus) recorded in Matthew 13:24-28 of something, which has taken place in the past and is taking place today in reference to our spiritual life. It states there **“Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, the kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in his field. 25 but while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat, and went his way. 26 but when the blade was sprung up, and brought forth fruit, then appeared the tares also. 27 So the servants of the householder came and said unto him, Sir, didst not thou sow good seed in thy field? From whence then hath it tares? 28. He said unto them, an enemy hath done this.”** KJV

**Who is responsible for the tares?** None other but the arch enemy, Satan himself. Satan was the one that inspired 19 young men to use these airplanes to cause this destruction of property and to kill 3,000 innocent people. Satan is out to steal, to kill and to destroy according to John 10:10. Here we talk about eternal life, eternal destruction, which is even more serious.

The parable in Matthew 13 speaks about the wheat and the tares growing up together in the Church. Besides true followers of the Messiah there are many false brethren that Satan has brought in. However, this parable can just as well be applied to false teachings and doctrines that Satan has introduced since the beginning of time.

Satan is diluting and watering down Elohim's (Elohim's) message and tries to change the law. However, he couldn't do it, if people wouldn't allow him to do it. They are the ones that are his agents.

As an example, He states in Matthew 5: 17-18 (KJV) **“Think not that I am come to destroy the law (the Torah) or the prophets, I am not come to destroy, but to fulfill. 18. For verily I say unto you, till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise from the law (the Torah) till all be fulfilled.”**

To fulfill means to carry out, to perform, to follow, to observe, to comply, not to do away with! Yahusha clearly said in these verses that he didn't come to make any changes in the law, meaning the Torah, the instructions given to Moses by adding or subtracting anything!

James 1:17 states: **“Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.”** KJV

What does that mean? **He does not change his plans and devise new ways to save man in different ages or dispensations. Because according to Malachi 3:6 “HE DOES NOT CHANGE!”**

He does not abolish the law to bring man into harmony with himself. There is only one way and one way only, whereby man can be saved from eternal separation from Heaven and alienation from Yahuwah Elohim, and that is **by faith in Messiah Yahusha (aka Jesus the Christ) and obedience to his Torah.**

First comes redemption through the Messiah and then obedience must follow, which is the only proof that we love Him. **Redemption must precede obedience! It does not work the other way! Only after we are redeemed by the blood of the lamb is obedience possible by His grace and power!**

Legalism says, **“I must obey in order to be saved!”** Grace says: **“I must and I love to obey because I am saved!”** Usually people do not have a problem with forgiveness but with obedience! However, both are necessary for salvation!

Yahuwah does not have a different system, neither a different set of instructions or laws for the New Testament believers then for the Old Testament believers!

The conditions of salvation are ever the same. Life, eternal life, is for all who will obey Yahuwah’s instructions.

**“The law (Torah) of YHVH is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of YHVH is sure, making wise the simple.”** Psalm 19:7



The Torah of Yahuwah converts the soul! Did you realize that? The Torah converts the soul!

How does the Torah do that? **It shows us our condition and points us to the Messiah!**

**After cleansing us from our past sins, He points us to the Torah, His commandments, statutes and judgments, so we can live a healthy, holy and happy life!**

Satan hates these instructions, because they are revealing **Yahushas character** and constitute the foundation of HIS (YHVH's) government. He hates Yahusha and whatever reminds us of Him.

**Therefore, Satan is working continually ... to obliterate the truth.** That's why he is sowing tares among the wheat as we have read in the parable Matthew 13:24-28



Satan also seeks to obliterate the line of demarcation between believers and unbelievers.

In other words: **Satan seeks to obliterate everything that would keep the true Elohim (Elohim) in remembrance.**

We should ask why? **In order that the professed Believers may be swept to perdition through separation from the Creator.**

As the most successful way to accomplish this, he has attempted to change the fourth commandment of the Decalogue and replaced it with his day, the Sunday, with a day that Yahuwah has not set-apart and not sanctified. Let's be honest, just look at the name SUN-Day, it is honoring the sun Elohim or BAAL.

Our Father knew that this would take place, that man would forget, that's why the fourth commandment starts with saying: **"Remember, the Sabbath Day, to keep it holy." Don't forget this Day, because it is my day, "Abba's" day.**


Since He is smarter than we are, He knew that amid the multitude of cares and perplexities man would be tempted to excuse himself from meeting the full requirement of the Torah and would forget its sacred importance.

There is another place in the Bible where we find the word **"remember"**. We find that in Malachi 4:4 **"Remember ye the Torah of Moses, my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel with the statutes and judgments."** KJV

Did the Yahuwah also know that there would be a time in the future, when man would forget the statutes and judgments? Someone did come along and tried to abolish them also! WHO WAS IT?

Here we have an interesting claim, which says: **The Catholic Church abolished not only the Sabbath, but all the other Jewish festivals.**” T. Enright, C.S.S.R., Bishop of St. Alphonsus church, St. Louis Missouri, from June 1905

Inspired by Satan, the man of sin removed Elohim’s (Elohim’s) day of rest (the 7<sup>th</sup> day) and replaced it with the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the week in honor of the SUN Elohim, claiming that this would honor the resurrection of Yahusha (aka Jesus). By the way our Savior was not raised on a first day of the week, but on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the week, if you study that out.



In addition Satan replaced Elohim’s (Elohim’s) yearly appointments or feast days (the 7 yearly Sabbaths) with pagan holidays. For what purpose?

**To honor himself and man’s attainments claiming to honor Christ by doing that.**

And the Bible says in Revelation 13:3 **“And all the world wondered after the beast.”**

All this was prophesied in Daniel 7:25:

“He shall think ...to change times and laws.” King James Version

The New American Bible: “Thinking ... to change the feast days and the law.” -

Here is the New Catholic Version: “..Thinking to change the feast days and the law.”

The Good News Bible: “He will try to change their religious laws and festivals.”

The Moffat Bible: “He shall plan to alter the sacred seasons and the law.”

The Knox Bible: “Calendar and ordinance he shall think to set aside.”

What did this power think to change? Times and laws, meaning **feast days and the Torah!**



The Bible states: “Thus saith YHVH, learn not the way of the heathen ... for the customs of the people are vain.” Jeremiah 10:2-3 KJV

### **Where did Christmas come from?**

Christmas is strictly a Roman Catholic word.

The word "**Christmas**" is a combination of the words "**Christ**" and "**Mass**".

The Catholic Encyclopedia states: "**Christmas was not among the earliest festivals of the Church. The first evidence of the feast is from Egypt. Pagan customs, centering around the January calendar, gravitated to Christmas.**

The date of December 25th comes from Rome and was a celebration of the Italic Elohim, Saturn, and the rebirth of the sun Elohim. All of the customs of Christmas pre-date the birth of Yahusha (Jesus), and are a collection of traditions and practices taken from many cultures and nations. The midwinter was celebrated by many cultures. **In Babylon it was dedicated to Queen of Heaven, in Greece it was to Dionysus and Adonis, In Rome it was a to Saturn, in England it was to the Nordic Elohim Balder but it is the Persian myth of the birth of the solar Elohim Mithra that is most likely the origin of Christmas.**

In Germany, the evergreen tree was used in worship and celebration of the Yule Elohim, also in observance of the resurrected sun Elohim.

The evergreen represented life and also was regarded as a phallic symbol in fertility worship. It was believed that the red holly was a symbol of the menstrual blood of the queen of heaven, Diana.

The white berries of mistletoe were considered to be the droplets of the semen of the sun Elohim. Branches of holly and mistletoe were hung in doorways of temples and homes and it was believed that kissing beneath them will make the spirits of the Elohim and Elohimdess to enter one's body and make them fertile.

Trees, wreaths, holly, mistletoe and the like are strictly pagan and heathen! Think about it! Can we worship and honor Elohim (Elohim) by involving ourselves with customs and traditions, which He Himself forbade as idolatry? Can we convince our Elohim to somehow "Christianize" these customs so we can enjoy ourselves?

**Can we obey through disobedience?**

We need to ask the question, what is right about Christmas? Does it have anything to do with Yahusha the Messiah (aka Jesus the Christ)?

**ABSOLUTELY NOTHING!**



What about the origin of Easter? *Vine's Complete Expository Dictionary of Old and New Testament Words*, in its entry "Easter," states: **Easter comes from a form of the name Astarte, a Chaldean (Babylonian) Elohimdess known as "the queen of heaven."**

(The queen of heaven is mentioned in the Bible in Jeremiah 7:18 and 44:17-19 and 25 and referred to in 1 Kings 11:5 and 33 and 2 Kings 23:13 and by the Hebrew form of her name, Ashtoreth.)

**So Easter is found in the Bible – but as part of the pagan religion, which Elohim condemns!**

How does *The Catholic Encyclopedia* define Easter? **"Easter: The English term, according to the [eighth-century monk] Bede, relates to Eostre, ...a Teutonic Elohimdess of the rising light of day and spring, which deity, however, is otherwise unknown . . ."** (1909, Vol. 5, p. 224).

*Eostre* is the ancient European name for the same Elohimdess worshipped by the Babylonians as *Astarte* or *Ishtar*, Elohimdess of fertility, whose major celebration was in the spring of the year. **"The egg has become a popular Easter symbol. Creation myths of many ancient peoples center in a cosmogenic egg from which the universe is born."**

"Scholars believe the name Easter is derived from Oestar, a Elohimdess of spring and renewal. The rabbit or hare was the symbol of fertility, new life and of the moon in ancient Egypt. It may have become an Easter symbol because the date for Easter is determined by the moon. Also the ancient Egyptians called the hare Wenu, an insignia of the rising of the sun, Ra, and of the restrictive powers of Osiris."



"Easter Rabbit" - "the rabbit is a pagan symbol and has always been an emblem of fertility".

Many credible sources substantiate the fact that Easter became a substitute festival for the Passover and Feast of Unleavened Bread.

*The Encyclopedia Britannica* says: "**There is no indication of the observance of the Easter festival in the New Testament, or in the writings of the apostolic Fathers. . . The first Christians continued to observe the Jewish festivals.**"

Again the question: "What connection does Easter have with the Scripture?"  
**ASOLUTELY NOTHING, IT IS 100% PAGAN!**



What is the truth about Valentine? Centuries before Messiah, the **pagan Romans** celebrated **February 15 and the evening of February 14** as an idolatrous and sensuous festival in honor of **Lupercus**, the "hunter of wolves"! (Encyclopedia Americana)

**The Greeks** called **Lupercus** by the name of "**Pan**". **The Semites** called Pan "**Baul**," according to the Classical Dictionaries. **Baal was merely another name for Nimrod**, "the mighty hunter" (Genesis 10:9) Nimrod was their hero - their strong man - **their VALENTINE!** Yet another of Nimrod's names was "**Sanctuc**" or "**Santa**", meaning Saint. It was a common title of any hero-Elohim. No wonder the day is called "**St. Valentine's Day**"!

**Nimrod - Baal or sun Elohim of the ancient pagans** - was said to have been born on January 6 (the winter solstice) and **his birthday was celebrated on December 25.**

**Semiramis**, the mother of Nimrod presented herself for purification on the fortieth day after January 6, which takes us to February 15, the celebration of which began on the evening of February 14 - the Lupercalia or St. Valentine's Day.

**On this day in February it was said that she appeared for the first time in public with her son as the original "mother and child."**



**Another name for the child Nimrod was "Cupid" - meaning "desire"** (Encyclopedia Britannica, article "*Cupid*").

It is said that when Nimrod's mother (Semiramis) saw him, she lusted after him - she desired him. **Nimrod became her Cupid - her desired one - and later her Valentine!** So evil was Nimrod's mother that it is said she married her own son!

**Inscribed on the monuments of ancient Egypt are inscriptions that Nimrod (the Egyptians called him Osiris) was "the husband of his mother."**

As Nimrod grew up, he became the child-hero of many women who desired him. **He was their Cupid! In the Book of Daniel he is called the "desire of women"** (Dan. 11:37).

Moffat translates the word as Tammuz - a Babylonian name of Nimrod. He provoked so many women to jealousy that an idol of him was often called the **"image of jealousy"** (Ez. 8:5). KJV

The pagans commemorated their hero-hunter Nimrod, or Baal, by sending heart shaped love tokens to one another on the evening of February 14 as a symbol of him.

**"In 496, Pope Gelasius changed Lupercalia on February 15 to St. Valentine's Day on February 14, and it became a Christian Custom."** (p. 172 of *Customs and Holidays Around the World* by Lavinia Dobler).

What has Valentine to do with Y'hshua (Jesus)? **ABSOLUTELY NOTHING, DON'T PARTICIPATE IN IT!"**



How did Halloween start? As with Christmas and Easter, we can trace the roots of Halloween far back into the pagan past. **Halloween is a celebration of darkness.**

By medieval times Nov. 1 had been established as All Saints' Day. **The evening before, Oct. 31, became Allhallows Eve, or Halloween, as it is known today.** (The Encyclopedia of Religion)

On this holiday **"huge bonfires were set on hilltops to frighten away evil spirits . . . The souls of the dead were supposed to revisit their homes on this day, and the autumnal festival acquired sinister significance, with ghosts, witches, hobgoblins, black cats, fairies, and demons of all kinds said to be roaming about. It was the time to placate the supernatural powers controlling the processes of nature. In addition, Halloween was thought to be the most favorable time for divinations concerning marriage, luck, health, and death. It was the only day on which the help of the devil was invoked for such purposes"**

(Encyclopedia Britannica, 15th edition, Micropaedia, Vol. IV, p. 862, "Halloween").

**Bobbing for apples** was originally a form of divination (fortune telling) to learn of future marriages. The first person to bite an apple was predicted to be the first to marry in the coming year. **Peeling apples was considered a way to determine one's life span. The longer the peel, the longer one would live.**

**The jack-o-lantern, now a hollowed-out pumpkin** with a demonic face carved in it and containing a lighted candle, represented a watchman on Halloween night or a man caught between earth and the supernatural world. The modern Christmas myth of Santa flying through the air also has a connection with the supernatural phenomena associated with Halloween.

**"Historically, beliefs about mythic Norse spirits and deities who flew through the air to gather souls and reward heroes influenced the Celtic fairy lore and witch lore that became a part of Halloween, and they also contributed to the development of the flying Father Christmas figure we know as Santa Claus, with his furs and his northern European reindeer"** (*Jack Santino, All Around the Year: Holidays & Celebrations in American Life, 1994, p. 26*).

What has Halloween to do with the Messiah? **Halloween is a celebration of darkness! STAY AWAY FROM IT!**

### **What about Mother's Day?**

Historians believe that the earliest celebration of Mother's Day was the ancient **springtime festivals in Greece and Rome**, dedicated to the mother Elohimdesses, Rhea and Cybele.

One of the earliest historical records of a society celebrating a Mother deity can be found **among the ancient Egyptians**, who held an annual festival to honor the Elohimdess Isis, who was commonly regarded as the Mother of the pharaohs.

**The Roman root** of Mother's Day is perhaps more precisely found in the celebration of the Phrygian Elohimdess Cybele, or Magna Mater (Great Mother).


**In Rome and Asia Minor, Cybele** was the major Mother deity most similar to Rhea, the **Greek mother of the Elohim**s. Other societies worshipped similar deities including **Gaia the Earth Elohimdess** and **Meter oreie the**

**Mountain Mother.** In many aspects, this Mother Elohimdess was represented and celebrated similarly across cultures.

A later incarnation of a holiday to honor Motherhood came from Europe. It fell on the fourth Sunday Lent (the 40 days of fasting preceding Easter Sunday). Early Christians initially used the day to honor the church in which they were baptized, which they knew as their “**Mother Church.**” This place of worship would be decorated with jewels, flowers and other offerings.

In the 1600's a clerical decree in England broadened the celebration to include real Mothers, earning the name Mothering Day. Mothers were presented with cakes and flowers, as well as a visit from their beloved and distant children.

In 1908 a U.S. Senator from Nebraska, Elmer Burkett, proposed making Mother's Day a national holiday at the request of the Young Men's Christian Association (YMCA). The proposal was defeated, but by 1909 forty-six states were holding Mother's Day services as well as parts of Canada and Mexico.



In 1914, President Woodrow signed a bill recognizing Mother's Day as a National Holiday to be celebrated each year on the second Sunday in May.

This is not intended to judge the motive of the people that established today's version of the mother's day but when considering the original motive and purpose we should consider the words of the Bible in Jeremiah 10:1-3

**“Hear ye the word which YHVH speaketh unto you, O house of Israel: 2. Thus saith YHVH, Learn not the way of the heathen ... for the customs of the people [are] vain.”**

### **The Origin of Lent!**

Since there is *no* instruction to observe Lent in the Bible, where did it come from?

**A forty-day abstinence period was anciently observed in honor of the pagan Elohim Osiris, Adonis and Tammuz** (John Landseer, *Sabaeen Researches*, pp. 111, 112). Alexander Hislops

*The Two Babylon's*, pp. 104-105, says this of the origin of Lent: **“The forty days abstinence of Lent was directly borrowed from the worshippers of the Babylonian Elohimdess. Such a Lent of forty days, in the spring of the year, is still observed by the Yezidis or Pagan Devil-worshippers of Kurdistan, who have inherited it from their early masters, the**

**Babylonians. Such a *Lent* of forty days was held in spring by the Pagan Mexicans...Such a Lent of forty days was observed in Egypt..."**

**Lent came from paganism, not from the Bible!**

Next, **what about Birthday Celebrations?** The answer may shock you!



Where did the universal custom of celebrating the day of one's birth originate? What about birthday parties, cakes, and candles? What does the Bible say about celebrating the day of one's birth?

If birthdays should be observed, then why is the Bible silent on the date of the birth of every single servant of Yahuwah Elohim, including Abraham, Noah, Moses, Samuel, David, the apostles, and most important of all, Yahusha the Messiah Himself?

When you look in the Bible from Genesis to Revelation, you will find no mention anywhere of any of the saints of Elohim observing their birthdays. In Yahuwah's sight, the actual time and day of a person's birth are completely **unimportant**. In fact, in Elohim's sight, as Solomon wrote in Ecclesiastes 7:1: "**A good name is better than precious ointment; and the day of death than the day of one's birth**" (KJV)

In Matthew 14:6-12 we read of **the wicked, apostate king Herod**, one of the worst butchers who ever lived. He celebrated his own birthday, and we know what happened! Again someone lost his life, this time a tremendous servant of the true Elohim, John the Baptist.

According to Linda Rannells Lewis (Author of Birthdays) , "**Birthdays were common celebrations for the ancient Egyptian kings and rulers. They had their horoscopes made by astrologers and their birthdays were considered very important omens of the future.**"

The astrology makes a great deal out of the positions of the sun, moon and stars at the moment or day of one's birth. Astrology teaches that the position of the sun, moon and stars at the moment of one's birth determines their future destiny, their character, their personality, talents, health, and so forth. The *World Book -- Childcraft International* says regarding "**Holidays and Birthdays,**" "**For thousands of years people all over the world have**

thought of a birthday as a very special day. Long ago, people believed that on a birthday a person could be helped by good spirits, or hurt by evil spirits. So, when a person had a birthday, friends and relatives gathered to protect him or her. And that's how birthday parties began."



"The idea of putting candles on birthday cakes goes back to ancient Greece. The Greeks worshipped many Elohim and Elohimdesses. Among them was one called Artemis."

"Artemis was the Elohimdess of the moon. The Greeks celebrated her birthday once each month by bringing special cakes to her temple. The cakes were round like a full moon. And, because the moon glows with light, the cakes were decorated with lighted candles."

"More and more, people the world over attach a certain magic to their actual date of birth ... We may wear a ring with our birthstone in it for good luck. And when we blow out the candles on our birthday cake, we are careful to keep what we wished a secret. If we tell, of course, our wish won't come true."

Astrology, as the Word of Elohim plainly shows, is a pagan, false religious deception -- a fraud and a mythological pseudo-science, and Elohim is against this according to Isaiah 47, 13-14. **STAY AWAY FROM IT!**

Why do people say "happy birthday?" One authority says "For the good wishes of our friends and relatives are supposed to protect us from evil spirits."

Someone else stated: "Party snappers, horns, bursting balloons, firecrackers, and other noisemakers are just one more way of trying to scare off any bad-luck spirits that may be hovering about."

Origen of Alexandria, in 245 A.D., wrote in a dissertation on Leviticus: "**None of the saints can be found who ever held a feast or a banquet upon his birthday, or rejoiced on the day when his son or daughter was born. But sinners rejoice and make merry on such days. ... But the saints not only neglect to mark the day of their birth with festivity, but also, filled with the Holy Spirit, they curse this day, after the example of Job and Jeremiah and David.**"

Yahuwah Elohim inspired the prophet Jeremiah to write, "Hear ye the word which YHVH speaketh unto you, O house of Israel: Thus saith YHVH,

**learn not the way of the heathen, and be not dismayed at YHVH signs of the heaven (astrology!); for the heathen are dismayed at them. For the custom of the people are vain..." (Jeremiah 10:1-3 - KJV).**



**Elohim expressly commands His people not to follow in the ways, customs, and practices of the heathen, the pagan nations around them!**

Celebrating birthdays **was a particularly Egyptian custom**. Elohim plainly commands His people, **"After the doings of the land of Egypt, wherein ye dwelt, shall ye not do: and after the doings of the land of Canaan, whither I bring you, shall ye not do: neither shall ye walk in their ordinances" (Leviticus 18:3). KJV**

Something to think about: **Should a Christian have anything to do with ceremonies that trace back to pagan times, and pagan rituals?**

Should a true Christian for instance indulge himself or his or her children in **pagan birthday parties**, just because they *seem* so attractive, fun, and "innocent"? **YOU DECIDE!**

Yahuwah declares: **"What fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? And what communion hath light with darkness? "Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the YHVH , and *touch not the unclean thing*; and I will receive you, and I will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith YHVH Almighty."** 2Corinthians 6:14, 17-18 KJV

**However, Yahuwah Elohim does say "Ye shall therefore keep MY statutes and MY judgments" -- which did not include any man-made holidays and there are many listed on our calendar that are in honor of man's accomplishments! -- (Leviticus 18:24-28).**

Isn't it about time that Elohim's professed people examine all these pagan customs of the world now falsely labeled Christian?

The Bible states in Zephaniah 1:8 (NLT): **"I will punish all those following pagan customs."**

Isn't it high time to let go of the Roman and Babylonian customs - this idolatry - and get back to the faith of Messiah delivered once to the saints?

Let's educate the people to stop keeping the pagan holidays with all of their customs and teach people instead what the Bible says!

Remember the message of the fourth angel that comes down from Heaven in Revelation 18:1-4 where it says **"...2 Babel the great is fallen, is fallen, and has become a dwelling place of demons, a haunt for every unclean spirit, and a haunt for every unclean and hated bird, 3 because all the nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her whoring, and the sovereigns of the earth have committed whoring with her, and the merchants of the earth have become rich through the power of her riotous living.4 And I heard another voice from the heaven saying, "Come out of her, my people, lest you share in her sins, and lest you receive of her plagues."** (The Scriptures)
