

Just for clarification: In my presentations I am using YHVH (Yahuwah) instead of LORD, which is a title and not a name and I am using Yahusha instead of Jesus, which is not a translation but a transliteration and really has no meaning, neither in Hebrew nor in English! YHVH (Yahuwah) and Yahusha are the actual original names and the true nature and character of them.

Yahusha *makes* the promise in John 8:32:

“Ye shall know the Truth and The Truth shall make you free!” KJV

Freedom is a most precious possession. Every creature desires and enjoys its freedom. Place a worm or an insect in a jar and it will work to get free. Put a dog on a leash and restrain him in one place and he will howl and bark to be set free. We humans are no different. **We want to be free!**

Yahusha is saying to those who believe: **“If you continue in my word, then you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free” KJV**

The key to genuine freedom is found in the phrase; **“continue in my word”**. We come to know the truth by continuing in His teachings, and truth and that only will liberate us or make us free.

THE EVERLASTING COVENANT!



Scripture states KJV: "The mercy of YHVH is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear Him, and his righteousness unto children's children; 18. To such as keep His covenant, and to those that remember his commandments to do them." Psalm 103:17-18

We must ask ourselves the question: **"What is a covenant?"**

In form, a covenant is an agreement between two people and involves promises on the part of each to the other. **The concept of a covenant between YHVH and His people is one of the central themes of the Bible.**

In the Biblical sense, a covenant implies much more than a contract or a simple agreement between two parties.

The word for "covenant" in the Old Testament also provides additional insight into the meaning of this important idea. It comes from a Hebrew root word that means **"to cut"**. This explains the strange custom of two people passing through the cut bodies of slain animals after making an agreement (cf. Jer. 34:18). A ceremony such as this always accompanied the making of a

covenant in the Old Testament. Sometimes those entering into a covenant shared a meal, such as when Laban and Jacob made their covenant (Gen. 31:54).

Abraham and his children were commanded to be circumcised as a “sign of covenant” between them and Elohim (Genesis 17:10-11 KJV)
At Sinai, Moses sprinkled the blood of animals on the altar and upon the people who entered into covenant with Elohim (Exodus 24:3-8)

What is an Everlasting Covenant? Eternal, forever!

YHVH’s Word is Eternal!

“The grass withers, the flower fades, but the Word of our Elohim stands forever.” Isaiah 40:8 KJV

“For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle (a tiny mark in the original spelling of a word) will by no means pass from the Torah (law) till all is fulfilled.” Matthew 5:18 KJV

Psalms 89:34:

“My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips.” KJV

There are five basic covenants in Scriptures that a holy, omniscient and omnipotent Elohim consents to enter with man, who is feeble, sinful and flawed!

- 1. The Covenant with Noah**
- 2. The Covenant with Abraham**
- 3. The Covenant with Moses**
- 4. The Covenant with David**
- 5. The Covenant of Messiah**

The popular teaching is that the so-called New Covenant that YHVH made with the death of the Messiah did away with the Old Testament covenants!

“It is being taught that “the old Covenant that Elohim had established with His people required obedience to the O.T. Mosaic Law – Jesus Christ came to fulfill the Law of Moses and created a new Covenant between Elohim and His people. The old Covenant was written in stone, but the new Covenant is written on our hearts...”

Some people claim that there was an “Adamic” Covenant?

Was there an “Adamic Covenant?”

The word “covenant” **does never appear in relationship to Adam!**

The Hebrew word “**bereth**” – translated as “**Covenant**” first appears in Genesis 6:18 with Noah!

The word “covenant” **does never appear in relationship to Adam!**

The Hebrew word “**berith**” – translated as “**Covenant**” first appears in Genesis 6:18 with Noah!

A Covenant cannot be entered into without the shedding of blood. But, there was no blood shed with Adam. There was blood shed when Yahuwah made clothing for Adam and Eve!

Exodus 24:8 “**And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the Covenant, which YHVH hath made with you concerning all these words.**” KJV

For that reason, there is really no biblical foundation for teaching the existence of an “**Adamic Covenant**”.



**Let's look at The
Covenant with
Noah!**

Genesis 9:8-17 And Elohim spake unto Noah, and to his sons with him saying: “I establish My Covenant with you, and with your seed after you; And with every living creature that is with you...And I will establish My Covenant with you; neither shall all flesh be cut off any more by the waters of a flood; neither shall there any more be a flood to destroy the earth. And Elohim said, This is the token of the Covenant**for perpetual generations: I do set My bow in the cloud ..**”

What are the Characteristics of the Covenant with Noah?

1. YHVH initiated this Covenant and it is **unconditional**
2. The Covenant extended to all following generations
3. It is a “Universal” Covenant
4. It was made with “all flesh” (Genesis 9:11)

And Noah sealed this covenant by offering animal sacrifices! The Blood of the Covenant – Noah offered animal sacrifices!



The question is:

1. Is the Covenant that was made with Noah still in effect?
2. Has YHVH kept His part of the terms? YES
3. The very fact that YHVH still keeps His terms is ample proof that this Covenant is still in effect.

What is the Abrahamic Covenant?

Is it still in effect?

In Genesis 17:10-11 we read that Abraham and his children were commanded to be circumcised as a “**sign of the covenant**” between them and Elohim! **Is circumcision still to be done today?**

Because Christians commonly understand that all animal sacrifices and the shedding of blood was fulfilled in the Savior's Blood being shed at Calvary, circumcision is believed to be ended at the Cross. **And if Circumcision, the token of the Abrahamic Covenant, has come to an end, it is ample proof that the covenant itself must have ended. But, the assumption that circumcision ended at the Cross is not biblical – consider what circumcision means:**



There is both a **literal and figurative** application of circumcision – the literal requirement (*circumcision of the flesh*) DID end at the Cross. But the figurative AND DEEPER meaning of circumcision (*the circumcision of the heart*) **still continues:**

Circumcision in the O. T.

Given as a sign of the Abrahamic Covenant

1. Genesis 17:9-14, 23-27
2. Romans 4:11

Patriarchs like Isaac, Jacob and Moses practiced it – passing the ordinance to Israel:

1. Genesis 21:4, 34
2. Exodus 4:26
3. John 7:22

It was required to observe the Passover:

1. Exodus 12:48

True Circumcision is Torah Obedience:

“And now, Israel, what doth YHVH thy Elohim (*Elohim*) require of thee, but to fear YHVH thy Elohim, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve YHVH thy Elohim with all thy heart and with all thy soul, to keep the commandments of YHVH, and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good? **Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your heart, and be no more stiff-necked.**” *Deuteronomy 10:12-16 KJV*

True Circumcision = a True Jew:

“For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither [is that] circumcision, which is outward in the flesh: But he [is] a Jew, which is one inwardly; and **circumcision [is that] of the heart, in the spirit, [and] not in the letter;** whose praise [is] not of men, but of Elohim.” *Romans 2:28-29 KJV*

The Abrahamic Covenant

Genesis 17:1-2 “And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, YHVH appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I Am the Almighty Elohim (*Elohim*); walk before Me, and be thou perfect. And I will make My Covenant between Me and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly.” KJV

Genesis 17:7-9 “And I will establish My Covenant between Me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an **Everlasting Covenant**, to be an Elohim (*a Elohim*) unto thee, and to thy seed after thee. And I will give unto thee, and to thy seed after thee, the Land wherein thou art a stranger, all the Land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; and I will be their Elohim (*Elohim*). And Elohim (*Elohim*) said unto Abraham, Thou shalt keep My Covenant therefore, thou, and thy seed after thee in their generations.” KJV



This Covenant was sealed **by a blood sacrifice** according to Genesis 15:17-18! “And it came to pass, that when the sun went down, and it was dark, behold a smoking furnace, and a burning lamp that passed between those pieces. In the same day YHVH made a Covenant with Abram, saying, unto thy seed have I given this Land...”KJV

Terms of the Abrahamic Covenant:

YHVH's Terms:

He will be our personal Elohim (*Elohim*) – *Leviticus 26:45*

He will give us the Promised Land as our eternal inheritance – *Genesis 15:18, Genesis 17:8*

He will deliver Israel – *Exodus 2:24*

Our Terms:

Humble our uncircumcised hearts – *Leviticus 26:41*

Keep YHVH's covenant – *Genesis 17:9*

Love and obey YHVH – Keep His Torah – *Leviticus 26:42-43*

The question is

1. Is the Abrahamic Covenant still in effect? YES
2. Has man kept the terms of this Covenant? **No** – (a covenant between God and man is NOT nullified by man's disobedience)
3. Has YHVH kept His part of the terms? **YES. Both in the New and Old Testament the token and terms of this covenant are still in effect.**



What is the Mosaic covenant?

Is it still in effect?

The Covenant with Moses isn't a new covenant – as we think of new – it was a renewed covenant – or better yet, a Remembered Covenant!

Exodus 2:23-25 “And it came to pass ... that the king of Egypt died: and the children of Israel sighed by reason of the bondage, and they cried, and their cry came up unto Elohim (*Elohim*) ... And Elohim (*Elohim*) remembered His Covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob” kjv

The Covenant with Moses was really confirming the Abrahamic Covenant!

1. Chronicles 16:15-17 “Be ye mindful always of His Covenant; the word which He commanded to a thousand generations; Even of the Covenant which He made with Abraham, and of His oath unto Isaac; And hath confirmed the same to Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an Everlasting Covenant.” KJV


The Covenant with Moses was really **confirming** the Abrahamic Covenant! What does it mean to confirm something? It means to establish, to make valid or binding, to acknowledge, to make more firm, to strengthen, to approve!

The Written Covenant is the Commandments of YHVH

Exodus 34:28 “And he was there with YHVH forty days and forty nights; he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And He wrote upon the tables the words of the Covenant, the Ten Commandments.” KJV

**Breaking YHVH's Law means
Breaking His Covenant with us!**


And that has serious consequences for us!



Leviticus 26:15-16 “And if ye shall despise My statutes, or if your soul abhor My judgments, so that ye will not do all My commandments, but that ye break My Covenant: I also will do this unto you; I will even appoint over you terror, consumption, and the burning ague, that shall consume

....the eyes, and cause sorrow of heart: and ye shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it.” KJV

Codes of Covenant




YHVH's Terms of the Covenant!

1. He would claim us
2. He would protect and provide for us
3. He would be “our” personal Elohim
4. He would bless us
5. He would love us selflessly
6. He would give us the Promised Land

OUR Terms of the Covenant!

1. We would worship **ONLY HIM**
2. We would obey **HIS** commandments, statutes and judgments
3. We would love Him selflessly
4. We would have no other gods.

Was something wrong with the Commandments, because the people broke them? Absolutely NOT!

Paul in Romans 6 plainly taught that the Law of Elohim (*Elohim*) was still to be kept.

A reminder for the last generation!

Malachi 4:4-6 “Remember ye the Torah (law) of Moses My servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, with the statutes and judgments. Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of YHVH...” KJV

All the past Covenants ARE STILL IN EFFECT!

What about the coming Covenant?

Today’s Christianity call it: “The New Covenant!”

The words “New Covenant” appear 10 times in the NKJV Bible, one in the Old Testament and nine (9) times in the New Testament!

Here is the verse in Jeremiah 31:31 “Behold, the days come, saith YHVH, that I will make a NEW Covenant with the House of Israel, and with the House of Judah.....” KJV

Jeremiah 31:31 = HS2319 – chadash (from 2318) – **new**
HS2318 – (a primary root) – **to be new; to rebuild:**
- new, repair

We find in the Hebrew that the words used for “New Covenant” actually mean – **“to rebuild, renew, repair”** – i.e. **RENEWED Covenant**. This meaning is conveyed clearly in the original Hebrew.

Here are the New Testament verses that are translated as the “New” Covenant: *Matt 26:28; Mark 14:24; Luke 22:20; 1. Cor. 11:25; II Cor 3:6; Heb 8:8; Heb 8:13; Heb 9:15 = GS 2537 = Kainos* – of uncertain affinity; new (especially in FRESHNESS);
Heb 12:24 = GS3501 = Neos – including the comparative neoteris, a primary word: “new”, i.e. (of persons) youthful, or (of things) fresh; figuratively, regenerate.
The Greek uses the word “kainos” 8 out of 9 times. **Kainos means new in respect to freshness – REFRESHED.**

Thus, YHYH will be able to renew this Covenant that had been disqualified from us by our ancestors rejecting & divorcing themselves from Elohim by rejecting the Covenant He made with them. Without the death of Messiah, neither the House of Israel nor the House of Judah would ever be reconciled to Him and brought back under the Covenant Of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

Jeremiah 31:31-32 “Behold, the days come, saith YHVH, that I will make a New (renewed?) Covenant with the House of Israel, and with the House of Judah: Not according to the Covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which My Covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith YHVH.” *KJV*

Ezekiel 37:21-27 “Thus saith YHVH Elohim; Behold, I will take the children of Israel from among the heathen, whither they be gone, and will gather them on every side, and bring them into their own Land: And I will make them one nation in the Land upon the mountains of Israel; and one king shall be king to them all; and they shall be no more two nations... Moreover I will make a Covenant of Peace with them; it shall be an Everlasting Covenant with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set My Sanctuary in the midst of them for evermore. My Tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their Elohim (Elohim), and they shall be My people.” KJV

**As we have seen, calling it the
“New” Covenant
Is a Poor Translation**

When Paul wrote about the “New Covenant”, He was quoting Jeremiah.

Hebrews 8:6-12 “But now hath He obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also He is the Mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises. For if that first Covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second. For finding fault with them, He saith, **Behold the days come, saith Yahuwah, when I will make a New Covenant with the House of Israel and with the House of Judah**: Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers ... because they continued not in My Covenant, and I regarded them not, saith YHVH. For this is the Covenant that I will make with the House of Israel after those days, saith YHVH; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a Elohim (*Elohim*), and they shall be to Me a people.... For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.” KJV

Paul was quoting here from Jeremiah chapter 31:31-34

Let's first ask the question:

With whom does it say that YHVH (the LORD) is going to make a New Covenant?

With the House of Israel and with the House of Judah!



Why not with Christianity?

Let's remember that Yahusha did not come to this earth to start a new religion, another church or another denomination! He came to reveal the character of His Heavenly Father and to point us as well as the House of Israel and the House of Judah back to the Torah of Moses!

That means He could not have started a religion called Christianity as we know it today!



I want to say it kindly, but Christianity as we know it to-day is a man-made religion. It is not the religion Yahusha Ha Mashiach started!

Does that shock you?

Are you surprised?

When you study history and Scripture you must come to the conclusion that Christianity is in reality a usurper, a hybrid religion based on many of the teachings of Yahusha but not the same religion He taught.

Esau and his Edomite descendants, were also usurpers. They sought to steal the birthright and promises that were **only given to faithful Israel**. **This is at the heart of the Replacement Theology.**

We must return to Torah and become spiritual Israelites, because salvation is of the Jews according to John 4:22!

Let's remember that the so-called new or renewed Covenant will be made with the House of Israel and with the House of Judah only according to Scripture! That means the Gentiles must engraft into Israel to partake of the blessings according to Romans 11.

The next question is: When does the Renewed Covenant go into effect? At the Cross? **NO!**

It states in Jeremiah: **"After those days"** He will "write His Torah on our hearts and minds."

PLUS: He will "forgive our sins" and "remember our iniquities no more."

At that time we need no missionaries any more, for **everyone** will know YHVH!

Has this day arrived?

No, it hasn't! What does that tell us?

This so-called "New" or better said "**Renewed**" Covenant prophesied in Jeremiah 31:31-34 and Hebrews 8:6-12 has not taken effect yet and will not take effect **until sin and sinners are no more!**

This is FUTURE! It is talking about the New Heaven and the New Earth, when sin and sinners are no more. However, that is not being taught by Christianity today.

The time the "New Covenant" takes effect is the time when HIS people **are sealed** and are beyond the power of Satan, meaning that his power over us will be permanently broken and we have received a heavenly nature with no bent to evil. "This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, said Adonai, **I will put My Laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them.**" Hebrews 10:16 KJV

This will be the time when our sinful natures have been removed as it states in Hebrews 10:1-2 "...**Because that the worshippers once purged should have no more conscience of sins.**" KJV

And YHVH will remember our sins no more! – See Jeremiah 31:34



"Remember ye the Torah (Law) of Moses My servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, with the statutes and judgments. Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of YHV ..." Malachi 4:4-6

Let's remember and return to the Torah, the statutes and judgments now! "...seal the Torah among My disciples." *Isaiah 8:16*

"If you will obey my voice indeed, and keep my Covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for the earth is mine: And ye shall be a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. ..." *Exodus 19:5-6 KJV*

Do we all realize what a high privilege and honor it is to enter into a Covenant relationship with the Creator of the Universe?



And it is unbelievable, difficult to comprehend how many people within Christianity are rejecting part of the Torah and especially the invitation to attend YHVH's yearly appointments claiming they ended at the Cross! By doing that, **they are breaking the Covenant!**

Not only that, but many times they become very angry and upset when they just hear about Torah or YHVH's Feast Days!

YHVH never breaks His part of the Covenant, He never breaks His word! Remember Psalm 89:34: "**My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips.**" KJV

Exodus 19:5 KJV “Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth [is] mine.”

This must be done **prior to His Second Coming** in the clouds of heaven; for when He comes, His reward is with Him, **"to give every man according as his work shall be."** *Revelation 22:12 KJV.*
