



The gospel confusion!

What is the gospel according to Scripture?

For clarification: In my studies I use the four Hebrew letters YHVH (and I pronounce it as Yahuwah or Yahuwah) instead of LORD, which is a title - not a name. I also use Yahusha (I pronounce it as Yashua or Yahusha) instead of Jesus, which is not a translation but a transliteration from a Greek mistransliteration. The name Jesus has no meaning, in Hebrew nor in English! YHVH and Yahusha are the actual original Hebrew names that speak of our Savior's true nature and character.

Note that all Scriptures are taken from the King James Version, unless otherwise noted!

So, what is the gospel according to Scripture? Yahusha and the apostles preached the "gospel"! But what is it? Was it the same gospel that Paul preached to the Gentiles? **What does "gospel" mean anyway? We will hear the answer from Scripture!**



Yahusha commanded, **"Repent and believe the gospel"** (Mark 1:15).

But exactly what is it that we are to believe? Do you know for certain? Be careful of assumptions. Did Messiah teach the same gospel that Paul preached to the Gentiles?

Was the same gospel preached to ancient Israel according to Hebrews 4:2? **"For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it."**

Many professing Christians do not know the answers to these most basic questions, and many others related to the true gospel of the Bible! This is because the knowledge of what the gospel really is has been hidden from the world for centuries!



Who stands behind such cover-up? Revelation 12:9 states that **“Satan...deceives the whole world.”** If this is true, then it would certainly apply to the truth of a matter so crucial as the meaning and correct understanding **of the GOSPEL!**

As we know, there are many false gospels being proclaimed! Some proclaim a “gospel of salvation,” others a “gospel of grace.” Still others believe a “gospel of miracles” or a “social gospel.” Yet others think of the “gospel of foods” or of “healing” or of “faith.” And there are some who merely think of “gospel music” when they hear this word. **These manmade ideas all ignore the truth of the Bible!**

YHVH Elohim inspired the apostle Paul to issue a warning to the Galatians then and to us now: **“I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Messiah unto another gospel: 7 Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you and would pervert the gospel of Messiah. 8 But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. 9 As we said before, so say I now again, If any [man] preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.”** Galatians 1:6-9

Although some assert that Paul taught a different or additional gospel, he never did.

Paul explained that the apostles were entrusted by Elohim to preserve **the true gospel**. Notice first Thessalonians 2:4, **“But as**

we [apostles] were allowed of Elohim to be put in trust with the gospel, even so we speak; not as pleasing men, but Elohim, which tries our hearts.”

Paul preached the gospel of the coming Kingdom of Elohim, but he did not neglect the subject of Messiah’s role in the salvation process.

First, Acts 19:8 establishes which gospel he preached: “And he went into the synagogue, and spoke boldly for the space of three months, disputing and persuading the things concerning the kingdom of Elohim.” In many of his epistles, he taught the Kingdom to Gentile congregations. His message was always the same. He continually preached, taught and referred to the Kingdom of Elohim and its restoration.

Next, Paul states in Acts 20:21, **“Testifying both to the Jews and also to the Greeks, repentance toward Elohim, and faith toward the Master Yahusha Ha Mashiach.”** He preached the same gospel to both Jew and Gentile.

Now notice Acts 28:30-31, **“And Paul dwelt two whole years in his own hired house, and received all that came in unto him, preaching (#1)the kingdom of Elohim, AND (#2) teaching those things which concern the Master Yahusha Ha Mashiach.”**

Luke, the writer of Acts, differentiates between preaching about the Kingdom of Elohim and preaching about Yahusha Ha Mashiach! While both are vitally important, they are clearly two separate subjects!

In Acts 8:12, the deacon Philip also preached both of these the same teachings: “But when they believed Philip...concerning (#1) the kingdom of Elohim, AND (#2) the name of Yahusha Ha Mashiach, they were baptized, both men and women.”

We see that Philip not only preached the Kingdom of Elohim, but he also differentiated it from the teaching about Messiah. Remember, the messenger is NOT the message!

The name of the Messiah was taught as an all-important, but additional understanding! He is NOT the gospel! However, He does stand directly alongside the true gospel and will rule the entire earth when He returns and establishes His Kingdom. Do not lose sight of this!

Finally, consider another verse where Paul himself made a distinction between the gospel and the person of Messiah. II Corinthians 11:4 contains this powerful warning, “For if he that comes preaches another Yahusha, whom we have not preached...or another gospel which you have not accepted, you might well bear with him” (the margin more correctly renders this last phrase “with me”). Paul wanted the Corinthians to reject false teachers and hold to what he had taught them. **The point here is that Paul distinguishes between the teaching of a false Yahusha and that of a false gospel. These are — and always have been — two separate things.**

Matthew’s account mentions “**gospel of the kingdom**” three times. Notice, “**And Yahusha went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people**” (9:35). In most of His parables, Messiah taught the basics of the kingdom of Elohim. Matthew alone makes over fifty references to it.

Luke records that Yahusha Ha Mashiach commissioned His disciples to preach this same message, “Then He called His twelve disciples together...And He sent them **to preach the kingdom of Elohim**” (9:1-2). Soon after, He sent seventy others to preach, and they also carried the message of the “kingdom of Elohim” (10:1,9).

Messiah standing before Pontius Pilate on the night He was betrayed, gave an important clue to understanding the kingdom: **“My kingdom is not of this world.”** John 18:36

The gospel of Messiah is His gospel about His coming kingdom, the restoration of all things.
The planet that was hijacked by Satan, will go back to the rightful owner, Yahusha Ha Mashiach.

Almost everyone believes that the gospel is about the person of Yahusha Ha Mashiach. Certainly, Messiah plays an extremely important and central role, **but He is not the gospel.** The Bible shows that Yahusha is preached **in conjunction with the gospel.** Again, His role is enormous.

Notice Mark’s account again: “Now after that John was put in prison, Yahusha came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of Elohim.” This is the gospel that Yahusha preached. It was in this same context that He said, **“Repent, and believe the gospel.”**

But He is not the gospel. “the gospel of The kingdom of Elohim!”

The word gospel is an old English word meaning good news. The word kingdom is also an old English term, simply meaning “government.” Therefore, it is accurate to say that Messiah preached “the good news of the government of Elohim.”

The kingdom of Elohim is the dominant theme of not only the New Testament, but of the whole Bible. The word gospel is found over 100 times in Scripture. Sometimes it is found alone, and sometimes “of the kingdom” follows it. Other times, it includes **“of the kingdom of Elohim,”** or the equivalent phrase **“of the kingdom of heaven.”**


The gospel of the kingdom of Elohim is all about the restoration of all things!

Bible prophecy foretells the times of restoration of all things. What will be restored to its former state? When will this longed-for renewal occur? **Let's find the answers from Scripture!**

Because Yahusha Himself promised in Matthew 7:7, **Ask**, and it shall be given you; **Seek**, and ye shall find; **Knock**, and it shall be opened unto you:

The apostle Peter spoke of the coming “times of restoration of all things” (Acts 3:21). The word restoration implies “a return ... to a former, original, normal, or unimpaired condition, or the restitution of something taken away or lost” Just what is this prediction about?

RESTORING THE KINGDOM OF YHVH, THAT IS THE GOSPEL!




Peter was speaking of a future time when things would be restored to their original state. The apostle explained that YHVH had spoken this prophecy “by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began” and that Yahusha would remain in heaven until it was time for this event to unfold.

All of Yahuwah’s prophets preached the kingdom. The apostle Jude, Messiah’s brother, stated, **“Enoch [Noah’s great-grandfather] ... prophesied...saying, Behold, YHVH comes with ten thousand of His saints, to execute judgment upon all”** (vs. 14-15).

These verses clearly are in the context of a world-ruling government with authority to execute judgment on “all.”

II Peter 2:5 refers to Noah as the eighth preacher of righteousness. Jude wrote that Enoch was the “seventh from Adam.” These men were called “preachers of righteousness.” Including Abel, there were six other men who previously held this role, with their lives spanning the entire period between Adam and the Flood.

In Genesis 12:3, Elohim said to Abraham, “...in you shall all families of the earth be blessed.” This verse is also referenced in Galatians 3:8 but is phrased a little differently: “...in you shall all nations be blessed.” **This same verse states that the gospel was “preached before unto Abraham.”** This is fascinating understanding! Not only did Abraham have the gospel preached to him (probably by Melchizedek), but it is also preached in Genesis, through the writings of Moses! How could all nations be blessed unless Messiah establishes His government on the new Earth?



Moses was the first man that YHVH raised up to lead Israel. While not a preacher of righteousness or an apostle, he was a prophet and a judge, preaching the gospel to ancient Israel when they were in the wilderness. Genesis 12:3 records the gospel, as does Numbers 24:17-19.

Acts 3:24 references Samuel as having preached the gospel, “**Yes, and all the prophets from Samuel and those that follow after, as many as have spoken, have likewise foretold of these days.**”

David was a king. But even he preached the Kingdom of Elohim! In Psalms 67:4, he wrote, “...for You [Elohim] shall judge the people righteously and govern the nations upon earth.” This obviously refers to YHVH’s coming government. Nations are on Earth, not in heaven!

Isaiah wrote, **“For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given, and the government shall be upon His shoulder: and His Name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The Mighty Elohim, The Everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon His kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even FOREVER” (9:6-7)**

Isaiah refers to YHVH’s future kingdom on earth!

Jeremiah wrote, **“Behold, the days come, says YHVH, that I will raise unto David a Righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth. In His days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is His name whereby He shall be called, YHVH OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS” (23:5-6, but also read verses 7-8).**

The prophet Jeremiah directly preached the gospel!

And Daniel wrote, **“And in the days of these kings shall the Elohim of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever.” Dan. 2:44**

Daniel preached the gospel of the coming kingdom on earth which will be on the NEW earth!

“The restitution of all things” can only occur with the coming of YHVH’s government on the earth made new! The restoration of all things is the GOOD news, which Yahusha has made possible!

Messiah is called the last Adam in 1Corinthians 15:45! This last or second Adam won back the kingdom that the first Adam lost to Satan through disobedience to a **“Thus saith YHVH!”** The first Adam fell, the last Adam was victorious!

Therefore, the restitution of all things, will take place at the Second Coming of Yahusha. The gospel of the kingdom of Elohim that had been preached since that time will become a reality!



In Matthew 6:33 Yahusha instructed His followers to “... seek ... FIRST the kingdom of Elohim, and His righteousness.” Therefore, we need to know what it is!

Yahusha even instructed His followers to pray for the coming of that kingdom in the example prayer recorded in Matthew 6:9-10 “Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. 10 Thy kingdom come...”

There are **FOUR necessary components of any kingdom**: (1) Land, property or territory, (2) a ruler, king, monarch or governor leading the government, (3) people or subjects living within the territory governed, and (4) a system of laws and rules and a basic structure of government.

According to my studies # 1 would be the new earth, # 2 Yahusha is the King of all kings, # 3 the subjects are the redeemed and # 4 are His instructions, which we call the Torah today.

Let’s quickly look at the subjects of that promised kingdom!

Besides preaching the gospel, the restoration of all things, Yahusha called for “**repentance**” of the people that listened to Him. **Take a note of this: One cannot enter the Kingdom unless he understands and accepts that “Messiah died for our sins,” and that person has accepted Him as their Savior and repented of his sins. WHAT CONSTITUTES SIN?**

“Sin is the transgression of the law (Torah)” 1 John 3:4 Yahusha died only for the sins that have been repented of and forsaken!

“He that covereth his sins shall not prosper but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy.” Proverbs 28:13

There are requirements to become citizens of this new earth according to Scripture as you can see!

Let’s just look at some texts of Scripture: “Except your righteousness shall exceed [the righteousness] of the Scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.” Matthew 5:20

“Many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven. 12 But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.” Matthew 8:11-12

“Woe unto you, Scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for ye neither go in [yourselves], neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in.” Matthew 23:13



“Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of Elohim as a little child shall in no wise enter therein.” Luke 18:17

“Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are [these]; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, 20 Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, 21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told

[you] in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of Elohim.” Galatians 5:19-21

Real repentance is to resist the devil and all sins. In Hebrews 12:4 Paul warns, by saying, “Ye have not yet resisted unto blood, striving against sin.”

We can only be part of the coming kingdom after we have been born again and are set apart and shun the world, the flesh and the devil! When we repent of our sins, are baptized in the name of Yahusha and begin following the lead of the Holy Spirit, **we voluntarily place ourselves under the laws and authority of the coming kingdom of Elohim.**



In Luke 17:20-21 we read the following, **“And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of Elohim should come, he answered them and said, The kingdom of Elohim cometh not with observation: 21 Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of Elohim is within you.”**

This is the KJV, other versions translate this part as **“the kingdom of Elohim is in the midst of you or amongst you.”** Many people think that this is a better translation, but as for me according to my studies I prefer the translation **“the kingdom of Elohim is WITHIN YOU,” meaning, it is in the hearts and minds of His followers. Only converted, born again people will enter that kingdom.**

We talk about the gospel of the kingdom of Elohim in this presentation, which is a gospel of restoration!



This prophesied restoration **begins with each person that confesses to believe in Yahusha!** He is honored only by those that believe in Him, as they are willing to be conformed into His image and controlled by His Spirit! **Yahusha is the potter; we are the**

clay! (Jeremiah 18:1-6)

Elohim always receives us in our old carnal ways and then He begins to reshape and mold us into a vessel that He can use, **if we allow Him to do it.** Our old man and old nature are still with us even after we're saved but He slowly but surely starts a work on each of us for His use and glory, **if we allow Him to do it.** The potter has absolute control over the natural clay; the clay will yield to the potters every demand, because the clay is lifeless and helpless in His hands. **However, man is different, than the normal clay a potter uses, he can resist and refuse to be molded.**

The natural man is very stubborn and stiff-necked when it comes to obeying YHVH's Word!



YHVH can only mold and change me into His image, when I trust and believe Him, **and I am willing to follow His instructions.** That means obedience to His Word! He cannot sanctify anyone that rebels against His Word and refuses to follow His guidelines!

Leviticus 20:7-8, **“Sanctify yourselves therefore and be ye holy: for I am YHVH your Elohim. 8 And ye shall keep my statutes and do them: I am YHVH which sanctify you.”**

In the Sermon on the Mount in Matthew 5 Yahusha shows how to live a life that is dedicated to and pleasing to Elohim, free from hypocrisy, full of love and grace, full of wisdom and discernment.

3 Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

4 Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted.

5 Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.

6 Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.

7 Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.

8 Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see Elohim.

9 Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of Elohim.

10 Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

These people are born again; to be born again, means to be walking in Torah! Torah reflects the character of the Lawgiver!

When Yahusha said in John 14:6 “I am the way, the truth and the life” – He said, “I am the living Torah!”



Part of the restoration of all things, what the gospel of the kingdom is all about, is that the Torah, His instructions, be restored into its rightful position, in the hearts of His people!

Most of Christianity teaches that the Torah with the statutes and judgments has been abolished at the Cross, even though Yahusha stated in Matthew 5:17 that this is not the case! **Part of the restoration of all things is to bring the Torah to the forefront.** See Isaiah 42:21 “YHVH will magnify His Torah!”

We are to magnify the Torah! The Torah must be restored before Yahusha can return. We are to be freed from sin, not from Torah. Forgiveness and mercy is given to them that repent of their sins.

The Torah is the compass of life. It provides our navigational fix, so we know where to go and how to get there. Without the Torah's guidance and direction, we would be lost in the stormy seas of confusion. Without a spiritual guidance system, we flounder about wandering aimlessly through life. Within the Torah lifestyle there is still ample room for spontaneity and freedom of expression.



In the Torah alone one can find salvation in Yahusha.

“You search the Scriptures, because you think you possess everlasting life in them. And these are

the ones that bear witness of Me.” John 5:39 (the Scriptures)

The bottom line: **“The Torah is about Yahusha!” Therefore, the Torah must be restored before Yahusha can return.**

Many traditions and practices in Christianity are of pagan origin, Scripture calls them **doctrines of devils** (1Timothy 4:1). For all things to be restored before the coming of Yahusha, the teachings and doctrines of man **MUST BE** rejected, **and biblical truth upheld.**

The fact is that the denominations, sects, churches, or factions, which make up Christianity are not followers of the genuine Savior of the world! The doctrines He taught, the life He lived, the worship He practiced, are not those of modern Christianity.

Christianity is Hellenic paganism, nationalized by Roman emperors for national solidarity. It was molded from the doctrines of Plato, Socrates and the Gnostic Grecian philosophers. Christianity is but a newer name of the old religion of the philosophers. It is modeled after them in doctrine, in practice and in worship.

Christianity, as such, was not firmly established as a religion until the time of Constantine the Great, who needed a national religion to solidify his empire. He, therefore, adopted the new religion, then going into apostasy, and made it into a national sect. He not only caused its acceptance as the one and only religion of the empire, but he formulated its policies, and caused its doctrines to be accepted, and stigmatized as heretics those who would not accept the new religion, banishing them from his kingdom, or putting them to death. Anyone may verify the above by referring to any religious encyclopedia on the topic of the Council of Nice, or the life of Constantine. Thus began the Roman Catholic Church, from whence sprang the church daughters making up the sects of Christianity.

Mainline Christianity is not the faith of the Savior, but an amalgamation of paganism, Judaism, sprinkled with a tincture of the true faith as taught by the Messiah. Hurlbut says, "As long as the church was mainly Jewish the Hebrew Sabbath was kept; but as it became increasingly Gentile the first day (Sunday) gradually took the place of the seventh" Story of the Christian Church, page 45.

Not only was the Sabbath dropped from the new religion, and Sunday (a holy day of the pagans) adopted; but they likewise rejected the Passover and the Feast of Unleavened Bread and adopted Lent and Easter (Astarte's Sunday). The Feast of Tabernacles and the Day of Atonement were forgotten, and the birthday of the sun god took their place as Christmas. Sprinkling took the place of immersion; immortality of the soul, adopted from paganism, replaced the doctrine of conditional eternal life; the resurrection and day of judgment were forgotten, and a continuous

judgment was taught, through which the dead entered heaven or hell for eternity, no resurrection being necessary in this program. ... This new church, so different, was Christianity, and for its deities it adopted various ones from the heathen, discarding the Most High of the Jewish scriptures, and His blessed Son Yahusha.”

All these false doctrines must be rejected BEFORE THE SECOND COMING OF YAHUSHA! This is part of the restoration of all things!



“Now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation!”

2Cor 6:2 DON'T WAIT DON'T Push it off!

The call is to come out of Babylon, but where should one go?

Yahusha is not calling you to join a man-made religion, an institution, a church or a denomination.

He is inviting you to give your life, your heart and thoughts to HIM alone. Go into your closet at home and submit to HIM! And be baptized by immersion in the name of Yahusha!

In order to be a member of any denomination in regular and good standing, you would not be able to follow a “thus saith YHVH” because you must submit to their established creeds or doctrines, even though they are not biblical.

Because the second commandment states **“thou shalt have no other gods before me!”** Exodus 20:3 Following the traditions, teachings and doctrines of man would be worshipping other gods!

I would like to point out that many Christians, but mostly Jews believe that the Messiah will establish his kingdom on this earth to reign for a thousand years from the city of Jerusalem. I recommend

you watch the presentation with the title **“the millennium deception.”** It is very unlikely that a holy Creator would establish His kingdom on this corrupted, poisoned, contaminated planet. **This planet must first be cleansed by fire and be re-created before He will come to establish His kingdom, which will not only last for a thousand years but for all eternity.**

Look at what Peter has to say in 2 Peter 3:10-12 **about the Second Coming of Yahusha and what will take place at that time:**

“...the day of YHVH will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up. 12 ... the coming of the day of Elohim, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat? ... we...according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.”



What about His people? “Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in Elohim, believe also in me. 2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.” John 14:1-3

Yahusha will return to take His people HOME. That is His promise, which you can take to the bank!

Just a notice, what is a mansion?

The Webster unabridged dictionary says, “A mansion is a very large, impressive or stately residence!”



Is that impressive?

EVEN THOUGH THIS MANSION IS ONLY AN IMAGINATION OF MAN!

However, Yahusha is not speaking of a mansion on this earth but in heaven, until this planet is being cleaned up and newly created!

For we are told in 1Corinthians 2:9 **“Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which Elohim hath prepared for them that love him.”**

This earth will be destroyed and cleansed by fire as we were reading in 2Peter 3!



“For the Master himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of Elohim: and the dead in Messiah shall rise first: 17 Then which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, **to meet the Master**

in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Master.”
1Thessalonians 4:17-18

According to these verses, the redeemed (the living and the resurrected righteous) will be taken to heaven and not remain on this poisoned earth for any period. Whatever remains on this earth and the earth itself will go up in flames! Is that what it states?

After this planet is cleaned up and purified from all garbage, filth, impurities and sin, it will be re-created. The New Jerusalem will

come down from Heaven, and only then will Yahusha establish His kingdom on earth.

This was the kingdom Peter was looking for when he wrote in 2Peter 3:13 **“Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.”**

All things will have been restored at this time!

The gospel of the restoration of the kingdom through the sacrifice of Yahusha, **is the same from Genesis to Revelation. The Torah is the same. The covenant is the same.** Yahusha, Paul, and James all affirm that the gospel is the same one believed by Abraham (John 8:56, Rom. 4:13, James 2:21-23).

Abraham’s obedient faith originated through his foreseeing Yahusha’s sacrifice. We are saved by Faith alone, but it must not be an intellectual faith as the devils have, nor a presumptuous faith that claims the promises of Elohim without complying with the conditions of salvation; **rather it must be a faith that works by love.**



The decisive issue at the end of time is: **whom will we worship and obey?** YHVH who made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters? (Rev. 14:7). Or the beast and his image? Obedience to the Torah with the commandments, statutes and judgments (that includes the weekly Sabbath and the yearly feast days) through the faith of Yahusha signifies those who remain faithful to the end. True love demands faith that is shown by obedience.
