

Today's presentation is called "Revive us again!"



This title "**Revive us again**" is taken from Psalm 85:6, which is a prayer pleading with YHVH: Here are the exact words: "**Wilt thou not revive us again: that thy people may rejoice in thee? Shew us thy mercy, O YHVH, and grant us thy salvation.**"

Sin has extinguished the love that Yahuwah placed in man's heart. The plea of the psalmist is to rekindle this extinguished love.

The desire and the prayer is to awaken His people and bring them back to their first Love!

Today as in ancient times Satan is continually at work to rock Yahuwah's people to sleep in the cradle of carnal security. After a certain time there is and always has been an indifference, a lack of zeal that paralyzes all of them.

Therefore the continuous call throughout all the ages was for a spiritual revival Coupled with a thorough reformation!

Does the last Ecclesia (*assembly*) need to be revived? Has Laodicea lost her first love?

All one has to do is read Revelation chapter 3 about Laodicea to find that Yahusha is not present in Laodicea nor does he have any part in Laodicea, even though Laodicea may talk, sing, pray und preach in His name. How is this possible? Can that be classified as judging?

A true revival will always be accompanied by a reformation, because A revival without A reformation is useless!

The Word says very plainly that Yahusha *is* standing **outside** the last church, called Laodicea knocking on individual hearts waiting for them to open the door so he can enter. Obviously the Messiah is not within the Laodicean Ecclesia as we read in Revelation chapter 3:21 KJV "**Behold, I stand at the door and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.**"

This is talking about the last, the 7th Church called Laodicea. But there is a personal invitation to open the door of our hearts. **We can really say that Laodicea is "a cold, lifeless Church or assembly."** Without the presence of the Messiah a gathering, a congregation is cold and lifeless, there is no spiritual life, it is spiritually dead. It is just a club with a Christian veneer!



The great majority Of the professed believers is spiritually asleep, better said in a coma!

Here again is the prayer from the past recorded in Psalm 85:6-7 KJV **“Wilt thou not revive us again: that thy people may rejoice in thee? Show us thy mercy, O YHVH, and grant us thy salvation.”**

Yahusha said in Matthew 6:33 **“seek ye first the kingdom of Elohim (Elohim), and his righteousness and all these**

things shall be added unto you.” KJV

Why is it so difficult for people to seek first the kingdom of Heaven? Because most people are trying to serve two masters! It cannot be done, It is either one or the other! Choose ye this day, whom ye will serve were the words of Joshua to ancient Israel!

Profession alone is not enough, going to worship once a week is not enough, going to prayer meeting every week is not enough if the life has not changed!

In Luke 12:49 Yahusha said: **“I have come to bring fire on earth, and how I wish it were already kindled!”** (International Standard Version)

We must be excited, we must be enthusiastic and on fire for our Savior! Aren't we striving for an immortal crown, striving for a home where there will be no need of the light of the sun or moon, or of lighted candles; for Yahuwah Elohim will give us light, and the redeemed shall reign for ever and ever having a life that measures with the life of Yahuwah?

Think of it! *Eternal life is of infinite value and it will take everything that we have. Here are the words of Yahusha:* **“whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple.”** Luke 14:33 KJV

The question is: **Are we willing to crucify self, accept Yahusha as our Master and follow a “Thus saith YHVH”?** Is it worth to forsake all and to crucify self in this life? Let's see what we read in 1. Corinthians 2:9

Scripture states in 1. Corinthians 2:9 KJV “Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which Yahuwah hath prepared for them that love him.” For whom? For them that love Him!

Therefore, let's return to our first love to HIM that first loved us! But this is not a forced love, we must seek this love, we must ask for it!

Psalm 42:1 states: **“As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after thee, O YAH.”** KJV

As the deer pants after the water brooks, so must we grasp, long, yearn, seek Yahuwah, His love, His righteousness, His presence, His salvation.

In Jeremiah 29:13 KJV YHVH is making the promise: **“ye shall seek me, and find (me), when ye shall search for me with all your heart.”** What is the requirement? To seek Yahuwah, the Creator, with the whole heart! We need a revival! We must be born again, Become a new creation!



The new birth is the beginning of life, to be born again is to begin the life anew. It is the means by which one gets into the kingdom of YAH!

We are talking about a renewal of our spiritual life, a resurrection from our spiritual death, a reformation of our life style!

“Therefore if any man [be] in Messiah, [he is] a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.” 2. Corinthians 5:17 KJV

There is indeed a radical change, when someone is truly born again and experiences a true revival and reformation. It is a New Beginning!

Many Christians like to sing that beautiful song, give me that Old Time Religion but do they really know what they are singing, do they have a clue what that Old Time Religion is? How far do we need to go back in order to find out what that Old Time Religion is?

All through the past 6,000 years the problem with Yah’s professed people was that they kept on forgetting and turning away from the instructions they had received from Elohim through Moses. They continuously turned from the law, the statutes and judgments. His professed people kept on corrupting themselves by learning the ways of the heathen and worshipping idols, which HE called “an abomination”.

What’s an abomination? **It is something utterly repulsive, vile, putrid and offensive!** Continuously in His great love and mercy for his people, YHVH sent them prophets, not only to tell the future, but to turn the people back to the old paths, back to the instructions given through Moses and to tell them to get back to the old paths according to Jeremiah 6:13.

The Torah, the first five books of Moses, is the foundation of the entire Scripture. If we do not understand Yahuwah’s plan as revealed in the Torah or the first five books of Moses, we can confuse the Scriptures for an entire lifetime. What are the old ways, what is the foundation they were to return and we are to return to?

“Great peace have they which love thy Torah: and nothing shall offend them.” Psalm 119:165 (KJV) Who are the ones that will have great peace? Those that love the Torah, the instructions of Elohim!

We read in Jeremiah 6:16-17 KJV for example “Thus saith YHVH, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths (ancient paths), where [is] the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But they said, we will not walk [therein].17. Also I set watchmen over you, [saying], Hearken to the sound of the trumpet. But they said we will not hearken.”

What do we call that? That is out and out rebellion!

Is there rebellion today? Today for example, in the western world we have grown up in complete ignorance of the Torah, in complete ignorance of the feasts of YHVH and have adopted pagan sun Elohim worship festivals in their place. Can we call that rebellion?

All of the pagan feasts like Xmas, Easter, Lent and Halloween etc are shadow pictures **of Babylon's fertility rites and child sacrifices rituals.**

These pagan feasts are shadow pictures of what? They are Shadow pictures of Babylon's fertility rites and child sacrifices rituals.

The yearly appointed feasts of YHVH for example **on the other hand** are beautiful memorials and rehearsals of what the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob has done in the past to redeem his people and what he will do in the future when he returns to establish His own kingdom to reign for eternity.

Scripture states in Hosea 4:6 KJV: **“My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law (Torah) of thy Elohim (Elohim), I will also forget thy children.”**

The whole Christian world has been infected with the parasitic doctrines of the Roman Church; they have been affected with Babylonian doctrines and practices and they even try to justify them with the Bible.

A true revival will cut loose from the doctrines and practices of Babylon! And that has to start with each individual, because salvation is first and foremost an individual issue.

One of man's biggest problem seems to be forgetfulness!

*What does YHVH have to say about this? **Because “thou hast forgotten the law (Torah) of thy Elohim (Elohim)”.** Hosea 4:6 KJV*

We need something to remind us continuously!

Has that ever happened to you, like meeting someone and you can't remember their name? You know their faces but you can't place them. Embarrassing!



What about forgetting our Creator's name, then His laws, statutes and judgments?

How would you feel, if in a conversation with another person and that person did not bother to learn your name? How would you feel, if as the conversation progressed, this person not only made no effort to learn your name, but made up a name convenient for them to use, regardless of the absolute disrespect that this showed? Now consider what the Heavenly Father and His Son must feel, when man has forgotten their name or changed the most important name found in Scripture.

Another question: How can you be in love with someone, intend to spend the rest of your life with him or her, and not even bother to ask his or her name? In Scripture we are told to hallow His name and to call upon His name. **How can we hallow His name or call upon His name, if we don't know what His name is?**

The good News is in Isaiah 52:6, where the Father says: "My people shall know My Name." And then Isaiah 42:8 He gives us His name, He says: "I am Yahuwah (YHVH): that is my name....." KJV

His name is mentioned 6,823 times in the Hebrew Scriptures and there is not a single text which prohibits us from calling Him by His Name. Remember **LORD and God** are not a name, but titles, which many no-Elohims have. These are neither translations nor transliterations of the Father's name.

The same applies to the Messiah. In John 5:43 Yahusha said: "**I am come in my father's name.**" How could this be possible if the Father's name is LORD God and the Son's name is Jesus the Christ? **How could the Father have a Hebrew name and His Son have a Greek name?**

A true revival and reformation will incorporate using the Fathers Name "YHVH" and the Son's name "Yahusha Ha Mashiach". Remember our Heavenly Father said in Isaiah 52:6 "**..My people shall know My name!**" KJV Check it out for yourself.

That is salvational! We need to be continuously reminded of these things and when we forget, there is the call to seek the old, ancient paths. Continuously Yahuwah expressed His unhappiness, His disgust, His dissatisfaction with ancient Israel's forgetfulness of Him and their resulting apostasy. Not long after they left Egypt they made and worshipped a golden calf saying: "**These [be] thy Elohims, O Israel, which have brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.**" Exodus 32:8


What an insult to Yahuwah, the life giver, the creator of the universe!

Again and again YHVH had to rebuke and reprove them of their forgetting Him and breaking the covenant they made with HIM. In Jeremiah 2:11-13 KJV he said: "**Hath a nation changed their Elohims, which are yet not Elohims? For my people have committed two evils; they have forsaken me the fountain of living waters, [and] hewed them out cisterns, broken cisterns, that can hold no water.**"

In Isaiah 1:3 KJV he says: "**The ox knoweth his owner, and the ass his master's crib: [but] Israel doth not know, my people doth not consider.**" They have forgotten!

In Jeremiah 2:32 KJV YHVH asked the question: "Can a maid forget her ornaments, or a bride her attire? Yet my people have forgotten me days without number!" That was in the Old Testament, the ancient children of Israel. Is today's generation doing any better, what do you think?

Since YHVH knew that man would forget His Creator and His law, the 10 Commandment, especially the Sabbath commandment he said: "**Remember the Sabbath Day to keep it holy...**"



Why did He use the word “**remember**”? Because He knew that people will forget and in His mercy he keeps reminding them to remember that He is the Creator and their very life, actually every breath is a gift from Him. Every 7th day on the Sabbath we are being reminded that **He** is the Creator, the life giver and the Redeemer!

Actually we need to be reminded daily of our dependence on Yahuwah. The Sabbath is not only a day of rest but mainly a day of worship **to be reminded** on a weekly basis that we owe our very being and life to YHVH, the Creator and our Savior. **It’s all about worship, but mainly for our own benefit!**

That’s why Abraham just as soon as he pitched his tent he erected an altar, where he offered his **morning and evening** sacrifices to His Creator.

Today Yahuwah wants you to offer up your morning and evening petitions to Him. Like the patriarchs of old, those who profess to love YHVH should erect an altar to HIM, wherever they pitch their tent. If ever there was a time when every house should be a house of prayer, it is now.




In every home Yahuwah should be honored **by the morning and evening sacrifices** of prayer and praise. Children should be taught to respect and reverence **the hour** of prayer. Just as the Father knew that people would forget the weekly Sabbath, when he said “**remember the Sabbath day**”, he knew that people would forget the other teachings of the first five books of His word, the books of Moses, called also the Torah. So He graciously reminded the last generation with the following words in Malachi 4:4:

“Remember ye the law of Moses (**the Torah**), my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, **with the statutes and judgments.**”

With the statutes and judgments explaining the 10 Commandments! What’s wrong with that?

He knew that His people in the O.T. would forget the Torah (the commandments, statutes and judgments), so in His great mercy he gave them some help to remember, he told the children of Israel in Numbers 16:38:



“that they make them fringes in the borders of their garments throughout their generations, and that they **put upon the fringe of the borders a ribbon of blue.**” Numbers 16:38

Again for what purpose? We find the answer in verse 40 KJV “That ye may remember, and do all my commandments, and be holy unto your Elohim.”

Today's generation could also use some kind of reminders to help us not to forget!

When Israel obtained special victories after leaving Egypt, memorials were preserved of these victories. Moses and Joshua were commanded of Elohim to do this, to build up remembrances. So when the Israelites had won a special victory over the Philistines, the Bible says in 1. Samuel 7:12

Samuel set up a commemorative stone and called it, Ebenezer, saying, ‘**Hitherto hath Yahuwah helped us.**’

We should ask ourselves the question, where are our commemorative stones? Where are our monumental pillars carved with letters expressing the precious story of what YHVH has done for us in our experience? **Don't we need such reminders today as did ancient Israel?**

The Bible tells us in various ways that we are to have the ‘faith’ of Abraham. However, we must find out what the faith of Abraham is and even more important; what it is not. Most people do not invest even five minutes a day to read His word, let alone study it in order to search out what they have been told. Our Heavenly Father has likened us to ‘sheep’. Sheep do not lead; they follow, many times blindly to their own destruction!

Whether you are Christian or Messianic 2. Timothy 2:15 directs you to “study and show yourself approved.”

The ancient sage ‘Rabbi Judah’ admonished to “careful study; for an error in study can lead to a presumptuous sin’. It would be wise for us to follow the examples of the Bereans in 2. Corinthians 10:12 KJV

These (*the Berean Jews v10*) were more noble than those (*Jews*) in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with **all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures (the Old Testament) daily, whether those things were so.**

The honest will always want to know what is true; the deceived ones always think they already know! The deceived ones think: “**they are rich, increased with goods and have need of nothing!**” That is their opinion, because of their blindness!



But in the eyes of Yahusha they “are wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked!” Revelation 3:17

The last generation needs to return to the truth of Scripture, but starting at Genesis 1:1 and not in the middle of the book. That means away from the doctrines and commandments of man and their traditions. There is hope, **IF WE FOLLOW THE ADVICE IN 2. CHRONICLES 7:14**

“If my people, which are called by my name (YHVH) shall humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land!”




When we submit ourselves to Yahuwah and resist the devil, he will flee from us according to James 4:7

In order to resist Satan, we basically must be falling on our face, humbling ourselves before Yahuwah. This is the only way we will be able to resist the deceiver and destroyer!

In Psalm 1:1 KJV we read: **"Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the unElohimly. . . . But his delight is in the law (Torah) of YHVH; and in his law (Torah) doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper."**

The Torah is the self-revelation of our Heavenly Father! And it is the Torah that directs man how to live and how to become holy! **A true revival can only take place if the Torah is being restored to its rightful position!**

Today's professed people of YHVH need to be revived and be converted again, but that is an individual matter and must start with you and me! It will not happen corporately!



A wife cannot save her husband; a husband cannot save his wife. Neither can a congregation save its members. Only Yahusha can save. We will not enter heaven's narrow gate two by two, or family by family, or church by church. **It is a single file.**

Therefore, each individual must seek to obtain the victory every day for himself. We must learn to stand alone, and depend wholly upon Yahusha. He is ready to help!

Psalm 121:2 **"My help cometh from YHVH, which made heaven and earth,"** and from HIM ALONE!

Let's not disappoint our Heavenly Father and Yahusha any longer but accept His invitation to the marriage supper by letting Him revive us again!

This is an invitation to every person to give his/her heart to Yahuwah anew! **To call upon HIM by HIS name and to remember the Torah of Moses, which include the yearly Sabbaths!**

The question is: **“will you and I accept the invitation to love Him with all our heart, soul mind and strength by keeping His commandments, statutes and judgments?”**



Only then will we experience a true Revival! It is only as the Torah of Elohim is restored to its rightful position that there can be a revival of primitive faith and Elohimliness among his professed people!

May this be our desire and decision is my sincere prayer!
