

Many people have lived their entire lives never realizing that their Father in Heaven has a personal name that is a necessary part of proper worship. This is the greatest cover-up in all of human history.

However, I in my presentations I will use HIS name YHVH as given 6823 times in the Hebrew Scriptures and as an example in Isaiah 42:8 KJV where He himself says: **“I am Yahuwah: that is my name: and my honor will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images.”**

Also the name of the Messiah, to which every knee will bow, and every tongue will confess, has been marred, changed, confused, and watered down in order to make it common and insignificant.

HIS name is Y’shua. It is the name that the Father has given him. Who or what gives us the right to change His name? Scripture states in John 10:27 **“My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.”** Therefore I will use His proper given Hebrew name in my presentation!



This is probably one of the most important questions we should ask ourselves! This is the question being asked in the context of the great day of YHVH’s wrath, the time of the Second Coming of Y’shua! However, it would be much better, if we asked that question long before that day, right now, so that we can be prepared! No one will be able to stand unless Yahuwah is his protection.



Scripture teaches that the end of this earth as we know it is about to come to an end. Our Master and Creator Y'shua Ha Mashiach will return very soon, if we believe it or not, if we are ready or not!

The signs are rapidly fulfilling, yet it seems that but a few take knowledge of this. It seems that very few people are even concerned or interested. The Bible states in 1. Thessalonians 5, 3: "**When they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them; . . . and they shall not escape.**" KJV



Can we see these signs? Have things changed during the past years as an example? Are we living in the same world that we knew 20 to 50 years ago? **Various signs are given by Y'shua that indicate the nearness of HIS Coming:**

1. False Prophets & Christ's (*Matthew 24: 5 & 11*)
2. Wars & rumors of Wars (*Matthew 24: 6*) and nations rise against nations (*Matthew 24:7*)
3. Famines (*Matthew 24:7*)

4. Earthquakes (*Matthew 24:7*)
5. Tribulations (*Matthew 24: 8-9*)
6. Preaching of the gospel (*Matthew 24:14*)

The world is falling apart, morally, financially, physically. There are other symptoms, like the excessive need for excitement, vicarious excitement, which of course the games provided for the Romans and which television and computers provide for our population. Then there is this terrible thing which afflicts materialistic societies - boredom, an excessive boredom which I note on every hand.

We see an increase of knowledge and travel, the return of one pure language (*Hebrew to Israel – Zephaniah 3*). The efforts of rebuilding the temple in Jerusalem. Plans for one world government and one world religion. Instant communication around the world. The collapse of the financial system etc.



**we do have some very encouraging words for those that belong to the Messiah in Luke 21, 28 "But when these things begin to take place, straighten up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near." KJV**

**Is it time to lift up our heads? It is too late to do business as usual. It is time to think of what really counts at the end! The majority of people conduct themselves as though this life were one grand holiday and they were placed in this world merely for their own amusement and pleasure. **They don't think about the afterlife. However, we are placed here to decide and to prepare where we want to spend eternity, whom we want to serve.****

*After talking about the signs of the times, Y'shua stated in Luke 21, 32 "Truly I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all things take place." KJV*

**We are living in the generation He is talking about. If we are ready or not, If we believe it or not, the terrible day of YHVH is at hand!**

**Therefore the message of today more than ever before must be "Prepare to meet thy Elohim (God), O Israel." [Amos 4:12.] This message is addressed not to the world, but to the professed followers**

**of YA, because most of them are asleep and occupied with the things of this life.**

There are so many professing believers who believe that they can just carry on living a worldly, careless life and keep on sinning, because they believe in Y'shua and that He shed His blood for them. However, it is not possible that Y'shua dwells in you and not cause you to separate yourself from sin and evil and the things of this world!

The prophet Malachi called the day of His appearance, the **“great and dreadful day of YHVH.”** Malachi 4, 5 KJV

Dread and terror will seize the people at that day. Neither grandeur, riches, valor, nor strength, will help anyone, for Y'shua himself will be their enemy, where shall we find a friend to plead for us? As men have their day of opportunity, and their seasons of grace, so YHVH has his day of righteous wrath. The idolaters are described as hiding themselves in their dens and secret caves, trying to escape ruin.

**We read in Zephaniah 1:14 KJV “The great day of YHVH is near – near and coming quickly. Listen! The cry on the day of YHVH will be bitter, the shouting of the warrior there.”**

**Then in Malachi 3:2 “But who can endure the day of his coming? Who can stand when he appears? For he will be like a refiner’s fire or a launderer’s soap.” KJV**

**It is so terrible that according to Revelation 6:15-17 “the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, were hiding themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains; saying to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb: For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?” KJV**

**Then in Joel 2:1 “Blow the trumpet in Zion; sound the alarm on my holy hill. Let all who live in the land tremble, for the day of YHVH is coming. It is close at hand.” KJV**

Joel states here **“let all who live in the land tremble”**. That would also include the believers. They will also tremble and shake, because this is a day of fire, lightening, thunder and earth quake.

We see how terrified Yah's people were, when the 10 commandments were given at Mount Sinai! Exodus 19:16-18 states that there were thunders and lightnings, and the whole mountain quaked greatly, so that all the people that was in the camp trembled, the good and the bad.

According to Paul in Hebrews 12:21, even Moses at that time feared exceedingly for his life and quaked, because the sight was so terrible. Everyone will shake in their boots at the coming day of Yahuwah, the good and the bad!

Yet at the end will it be great for those you made YHVH their MASTER **first by wholehearted repentance and then by obedience to HIS word**, but dreadful for those who rejected HIM, those who did not repent and refuse to obey His commandments, statutes and judgments. The Day of HIS coming is a day of destruction only to evil, but it is a day of redemption, not only for YHVH's people, but for the whole creation. As Romans 8, 22 states, that all living things are weeping and sorrowing in pain. The whole creation has been affected by sin and rebellion! *(Bible in Basic English)*



**The all-important Question is:  
Will you and I be able to stand in that day?**


Are you, am I preparing our hearts and mind in order to get our life in order so we can meet the coming King in peace? We can only stand, if HE is our shield and if we are sealed! Therefore our Savior is admonishing us in Luke 21:36: "**Watch** ye therefore, and **pray** always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man. " KJV



**What does It mean to watch?  
It means to be awake, sleepless. In the spiritual sense it means be vigilant and on guard, fully awake, aware, alert and intently focused! The biblical command to watch is coupled with the command to pray. Watch and pray!**

The great day of YHVH is a serious matter for both believers and especially for non-believers. It is wise to be serious about that day and to be ready before it is ever too late. Time for this generation is running out! It is too late to please yourself. It is too late to be concerned about the frivolous things of this life. It is too late to feed with milk, to be satisfied with a superficial religion.

The closer we draw to the Second Coming of Y'shua, the more urgent it is that we awake out of spiritual sleep! We have entered the fearful end-time years that are the grand climax of human civilization. If ever there was a time to pay attention and get prepared, it is now! Furthermore, none of us knows when he or she will die. Being spiritually prepared for the end of life should be our top priority.




Again our Savior's words in Mark 13:37: **"What I say unto you I say unto all, Watch." KJV**

According to His Word the large majority of people, especially professed Christians are not ready, they are not prepared for that great day! How do I know? One example we have in Matthew 25 and Luke chapter 13! Here we have the parable of the 10 virgins.



Scripture says that of the ten virgins that went out to meet the bridegroom **“5 were prepared and 5 were not!”**

Think about it: All ten virgins went out to meet the bridegroom! All made a profession! All had lamps! All had vessels for oil! All had oil in their lamps, all had some oil in their vessels, but not enough. All had a knowledge of the Scriptures! All were waiting! All knew that He was coming soon! However, five were not prepared for that event. Doesn't the Bible say in Hosea 4:6 KJV **“My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge?”** They don't know why they believe what they believe. So what is the outcome?



In that parable, five of them heard these terrible words according to Luke 13:27: **“I know you not whence ye are; depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity.” KJV**


I don't know who you are! They really had no fellowship with the Savior, even though they claimed to know him, but HE didn't know them. They thought they knew Him, but they really did not. They followed a wrong Messiah. They knew not the language of heaven, they are strangers to its joy. They obviously did not first seek the kingdom of heaven, they claimed to follow HIM, but in reality they didn't.

**Are these serious words? Should we be concerned?**

Then in Verse 28 of Luke 13 he continued saying: *“There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God, and you [yourselves] thrust out.”*

KJV

Another example we find in Matthew 7:22-23 KJV, where Y'shua stated: **“Many will say to me in that day, Master, Master, have we not prophesied in thy name? And in thy name have cast out devils? And in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity!”** Matthew 7, 23



So what does it exactly mean “depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity?”

**“anomos”**

The word “iniquity” or “lawlessness” in this verse is translated from the Greek word

**Ye that are without Torah!**

**And what is meant by the Torah?**

**“a” = without and “nomos” Torah**

**Most people believe that because they belong to a certain religious denomination, they have the ticket to heaven! But will that do the trick? There are actually more than 41,000 Christian churches, denominations and groups and all claim that they are the right one? You talk about confusion and there is only one Bible and one Creator! Would you say that Satan has pulled a good one on peoples mind? But**

what does Scripture say in Revelation 14:1-5 in reference to the redeemed?

*Talking about the redeemed, actually the 144,000 standing with the Lamb on Mount Zion, we read in Revelation 14:4 “These are they, which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth .....” KJV*

**Women in Scripture are organized churches!**

Scripture talks about a pure woman, the true church and a harlot woman, the apostate church.

The pure woman, the pure assembly follows the LAMB and HIS instructions, the Torah, meaning not the traditions or doctrines of man!


People are being put in a box of man-made teachings, traditions and creeds! Every church may have some truth, but not all truth. They got stuck somewhere and refuse to go any further. Instead of growing, they have become stagnant, they are at a standstill, and that for centuries. If the Holy Spirit wants to teach you something out of Scripture, which is contrary to their established creeds, to their established teachings you can't get out, you are stuck in that particular organization! You must believe and do what they have established as doctrine.

Now you must decide to choose between the established doctrines within that organization and the Creator of the universe.

Organizations have become businesses without the presence of YHVH. That's exactly what happened during the time of Messiah. There was a religious establishment, there were Pharisees and Sadducees, and there were established teachings. In addition to the written Torah of Moses they had the oral Torah, traditions of man, called the Talmud, which they placed above the written Torah, above a “Thus saith YHVH.” That's why the words of Y'shua in Mark 7:7



**“In vain do they worship me, teaching [for] doctrines the commandments of men.” Mark 7:7 KJV**



It states in Acts 24:5 **“For we have found this man [a] pestilent [fellow], and a mover of sedition among all the Jews throughout the world, and a ringleader of the sect of the Nazarenes.” KJV**

Was Paul a pestilent fellow? Was he a mover of sedition among the Jews throughout the world? Was he a preacher of heresies?

**When you read Scripture, you find that Paul was a defender of the teachings of Moses and the prophets, the Torah!**

**Those who will be able to stand at the last day, will have built their faith, their trust, their doctrines on a sure foundation, called Torah, the instructions of Yahuwah!**



Y'shua stated in Matthew 7:24 KJV that **“whosoever heareth his sayings, and doeth them, is likened unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock.”**

Y'shuas sayings are not in contradiction to Torah. He stated that He did not come to abolish Torah but to uphold it! Matthew 5:17 **“Don't suppose that I came to do away with the Law (Torah) and the Prophets. I did not come to do away with them, but to give them their full meaning.”** CEV (Contemporary English Version)

Y'shua lived his life as a Torah-observant Jew. He was Jewish. His parents were Jewish. His followers, including James and Mary and Peter and Paul, were Jewish. And, so far as we can tell, the movement of his followers remained both Jewish and Torah-observant for some time.

If you want to be able to stand at the last day, uphold and follow Torah, with the statutes and judgments, no matter what anyone else says!

*Deuteronomy 4:7-8* **“For what nation [is there so] great, who [hath] God [so] nigh unto them, as YHVH our God [is] in all [things that] we call upon him [for]? 8. And what nation [is there so] great, that hath statutes and judgments [so] righteous as all this law (Torah), which I set before you this day?”** KJV

Here are implicit instructions from YHVH in Deuteronomy 4:1-2 “Now therefore hearken, O Israel, unto the statutes and unto the judgments, which I teach you, for to do [them], that ye may live, ... **Ye shall not add** unto the word which I command you, **neither shall ye diminish [ought] from it**, that ye may keep the commandments of YHVH your Elohim, which I command you. “ KJV



“What thing so-ever I command you, observe to do it: thou shalt not add thereto, nor diminish from it.”

*Deuteronomy 12:32 KJV*

**The Torah is the self-revelation of YHVH.** With his stories, statutes, laws, commandments and ordinances we come to understand the heart and mind of our Creator. The Torah of the O.T. is the root, the foundation and the Messiah (Y'shua) of the N.T. is the revelation, the fulfillment. The Torah is the teaching that directs man how to live and no man, organization, church or people have the authority to add or to subtract anything.

The Torah is a wall of protection to those who are obedient to YHVH's precepts.

## **Despite that prohibition, what has happened to YHVH's instructions?**

Many changes were made by man, despite the command not to do it!

Changes were made to the Torah by false shepherds clothed in sheep's clothing among the followers of Y'shua! The churches became corrupt! Satan was the mastermind behind all this!

Paul already warned us in 2. Corinthians 11:3-4 that there would be:

A false (counterfeit) Messiah,  
A false (counterfeit) Spirit  
A false (counterfeit) Gospel!


Now let's come to the question again "Who shall be able To stand?"

*Revelation 6, 17*

Will we stand, when we follow pagan doctrines and teachings? Only those that love the Truth, teach the Truth and live by the Truth, will He acknowledge as His own and that will be able to stand on that day!

*We can only stand, as long as YHVH is our fortress and our rock as recorded in Psalm 18:2 KJV "YHVH [is] my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, [and] my high tower."*

*"YHVH [is] my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer." 2. Samuel 22:2 KJV*



**"YHVH [is] my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear?  
YHVH [is] the strength of my life;  
of whom shall I be afraid?" Psalm 27:1 KJV**

**“YHVH [is] good, a strong hold in the day of trouble; and he knoweth them that trust in him.” Nahum 1:7 KJV**

However, YHVH’s promises of being our rock, our fortress, our defense, our help in times of need **are conditional!** Here are just some examples of conditions:

### **Condition for healing!**

**“If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of YHVH thy Elohim, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I [am] YHVH that healeth thee.” Exodus 15:26 KJV**

### **Condition of blessings!**

**“If thou wilt hearken unto all that I command thee, and wilt walk in my ways, and do [that is] right in my sight, to keep my statutes and my commandments, as David my servant did; that I will be with thee, and build thee a sure house, as I built for David, and will give Israel unto thee.” 1.Kings 11:38 KJV**

### **Condition of long life!**


**“That thou mightest fear YHVH your Elohim, to keep all his statutes and his commandments, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son’s son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged.” Deuteronomy 6:2 KJV**

*King David asked the same question in Psalm 15 “YHVH, who shall abide in thy tabernacle? Who shall dwell in thy holy hill?” KJV*

### **Here is his answer:**

- 2. “He that walketh uprightly, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh the truth in his heart.” KJV**
- 3. “He that backbiteth not with his tongue, nor doeth evil to his neighbor, nor taketh up a reproach against his neighbor.”**
- 4. In whose eyes a vile person is contemned; but he honoureth them that fear YHVH. He that sweareth to his own hurt, and changeth not.”**
- 5. He that putteth not out his money to usury, nor taketh reward against the innocent. He that doeth these things shall never be moved.“**

Who only will be able to stand On that great day?



Scripture states in Revelation 7:4 that the final plagues will not come, until the sealing has taken place!

Revelation 7:2-3 KJV “And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living Elohim (*God*): and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads. “ *Revelation 7:3 KJV*

With what is man being sealed according to Isaiah 8:16?



**“Bind up the testimony, seal the Torah among my disciples.”**  
*Isaiah 8:16 KJV*

It always comes back to the Torah, which reflects the character of YHVH, which paints a picture of our Creator. Within his stories, statutes, judgments, laws, commandments and ordinances we come to understand the heart and mind of our Creator. Torah is the foundation of His government. No wonder Satan wants to nail it to the cross.

**“The mercy of YHVH is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him ...to such as keep his covenant ...” Psalm 103:17-18 KJV**

**We find his covenant in Exodus chapters 21, 22 and 23 that was ratified in Chapter 24 and it includes Yahuwah's yearly appointed feast days.**

**That covenant is still in force!**

**We are serving a covenant keeping Elohim (*God*)! Let's be a covenant keeping people!**

**We were just reading in Psalm 103:17-18 KJV that “The mercy of YHVH is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him ...to such as keep his covenant ...” YHVH expects his people to keep His covenant, no it did not end at the cross!**

**Only as we have repented and forsaken our sins, been washed in the blood of the Lamb and obey His commandments, statutes and Judgments, keeping His covenant will we by His grace be able to stand in the last great day! There is NO other way!**
