WHAT IS TAROT?

Tarot is a deck of 78 cards, each with its own imagery, symbolism, and story. The cards are divided into two main sections: the Major Arcana, which consists of 22 cards representing life's karmic and spiritual lessons, and the Minor Arcana, which consists of 56 cards that reflect the trials and tribulations of daily life.

The tarot has evolved over centuries into a powerful tool for divination, self-discovery, and spiritual guidance.

The images on the cards are rich in symbols and meanings, and a tarot reading involves a practitioner interpreting the cards' positions and their relationships to one another. In this way, a tarot reader can provide insights into complex situations, offer perspectives on personal challenges, and predict potential outcomes.

WHAT IS THE TAROT CARD YEAR?

The Tarot Card Year is a concept used to represent your personal theme or primary energetic influence for a given year. Because it is a blend of numerology and tarot, a calculation is used to identify a specific tarot card from the Major Arcana that corresponds to the year of interest based on your date of birth and the current year. This card symbolizes the lessons, challenges, and opportunities that will be significant during that year.

Benefits of Understanding Your Tarot Card Year

Guidance and Focus

- It provides a thematic focus for reflection and personal development throughout the year. Understanding the energy of the card can help you align your actions with the broader themes of your life.

- The card can indicate potential challenges and opportunities, allowing for proactive planning and a better understanding of what to expect.

- The tarot card year offers a lens through which we can be introspective which can lead to personal growth and self-improvement.

- It offers insights into the energies at play, helping you adapt your strategies to navigate your personal and professional life more effectively.

CALCULATING YOUR TAROT CARD YEAR

1 - Write down your birth month and day. Do not include the year.
(You may use the worksheet on the next page)

2 - Write down the year that you are calculating for (not your birth year)

3 - Add together the numbers of your birth month, day, and the numbers of the current year (or the year you are calculating for).

4 - Reduce these to a digit between 1 and 22 (the number of Major Arcana cards).

Example

For someone born on October 13 and the current year is 2024, the calculation would be 10 (month) + 13 (day) + 2024 (year) = 2047, then $2+0+4+7 = 13$.

The 13th card in the Major Arcana is the Death card, indicating a year of transformation and endings leading to new beginnings.

TAROT CARD MEANINGS SUMMARY

1 - The Magician (I)

- Manifestation, resourcefulness, and new opportunities. A year to use your skills to achieve your goals.

2 - The High Priestess (II)

- Intuition, mystery, and inner knowledge. A year to trust your instincts and look beyond the obvious.

3 - The Empress (III)

- Fertility, creativity, and abundance. A year to nurture projects and relationships.

4 - The Emperor (IV)

- Authority, structure, and control. A year to establish order and firm boundaries.

5 - The Hierophant (V)

- Tradition, conventional expectations, and learning. A year to honor traditions or seek spiritual guidance.

6 - The Lovers (VI)

- Relationships, choices, and moral dilemmas. A year to focus on personal or romantic relationships.

7 - The Chariot (VII)

- Determination, victory, and overcoming obstacles. A year to stay focused on your goals and face challenges head-on.

8 - Strength (VIII)

- Courage, persuasion, and inner strength. A year to tame inner beasts and harness personal power.

9 - The Hermit (IX)

- Solitude, introspection, and self-discovery. A year to seek wisdom and inner guidance.

10 - Wheel of Fortune (X)

- Cycles, fate, and significant changes. A year where fortune turns in your favor, expect unexpected events.

11 - Justice (XI)

- Fairness, truth, and law. A year to seek justice, balance, and resolve legal matters.

12 - The Hanged Man (XII)

- Letting go, suspension, and new perspectives. A year to pause and view the world from a different angle.

13 - Death (XIII)

- Transformation, endings, and transitions. A year to close one chapter and prepare for a new one.

14 - Temperance (XIV)

Balance, moderation, and purpose. A year to find stability and practice moderation.

15 - The Devil (XV)

- Attachment, addiction, and materialism. A year to confront and release unhealthy attachments.

16 - The Tower (XVI)

- Upheaval, breakdowns, and sudden change. A year to brace for impact and rebuild stronger.

17 - The Star (XVII)

- Hope, faith, and rejuvenation. A year to heal and be inspired by your dreams.

18 - The Moon (XVIII)

- Illusion, fear, and confusion. A year to face hidden truths and overcome fears.

19 - The Sun (XIX)

20 - Judgment (XX)

- Reflection, rebirth, and inner calling. A year to assess past actions and make significant life changes.
