



A NOTE FOR GROWN-UPS

This activity goes hand-in-hand with "The Love That Stays."

In the story, your child discovered something special: a tiny letter box that lives inside their chest. A place where love stays, even when someone isn't here anymore.

This page is a chance for them to bring that letter box to life and make it truly their own.

How to use this activity

There's no right or wrong way to do this. Let your child lead, and simply follow where their imagination takes them. If they'd like a little help getting started, here are some gentle questions you might ask:

- What colour is your letter box?
- Is it big or small?
- What shape is it?
- What's on the outside? (Flowers? Stars? Their pet's name?)
- Does it have a pattern?
- Does it glow?
- What does the little slot at the top look like?
- Is there anything special about it that only you know?

Some will draw quickly and confidently. Some will want to talk through every tiny detail. Some will change their mind a hundred times. Some will keep it beautifully simple. Some will add things you never expected. All of this is perfect.
