

ROUND THREE

Materials:

- Three D10 (10-sided die)
- Two different colors (markers, crayons, or pencils)

Instructions

- On your turn, roll all three D10.
- Use the three numbers in any order to create a number with a decimal point placed anywhere.
- Round the number to the nearest whole number.
- Mark that number on the board.
- The goal is to get three numbers in a row: vertically, horizontally, or diagonally.

Variations

- **Round Four:** Play with FOUR D10s for an added challenge
- **Announce It:** Before rolling, the player must announce whether they will round up or down.
- **Easier Version:** Play with a D10 and a Percentile Dice (one that has 10, 20, 30, etc). The percentile dice is the tens place and the D10 is the ones place.
