

# ULTIMATE TIC TAC TOE

- When a player wins a small tic-tac-toe board, that entire board is claimed with their symbol (X or O) on the large grid.
- The goal is to win the large tic-tac-toe board by getting three claimed boards in a row (vertically, horizontally, or diagonally).
- **Option A:** Players can go in ANY of the squares on any space
- **Option B:** On the first turn, Player 1 may place a mark in any square of any small board.
- The position of that mark determines where the next player must play on the large grid.
- For example: If Player 1 places an X in the center square of the upper-right small board, Player 2 must play in any square of the center small board.
- Players continue taking turns following this rule.
